
## Block 6: Friendship Stars

Use one light, one medium, and one dark fabric.


## **Instructions:**


Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise stated.

- 1. Cut fabrics:
  - Eight squares 2%" x 2%" (light) A
  - Eight squares 27/8" x 27/8" (dark) B
  - Sixteen squares 27/8" x 27/8" (medium) C
  - Four squares 2½" x 2½" (dark) D
- 2. Create half square triangle blocks:
  - Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of one light A square and place it on one medium C square; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut in half and press toward C. Make sixteen medium half square triangle blocks.



3. Repeat Step 2 using remaining eight medium C squares and eight dark B squares. Make sixteen dark half square triangle blocks.





- 4. Create block:
  - Lay out medium half square triangles, dark half square triangles, and D squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Friendship Stars block measuring 12½" square.
