# Nancy's Notions Free Quilt Block Pattern 

## Block 6: Friendship Stars

Use one light, one medium, and one dark fabric.

## Instructions:

Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut fabrics:

- Eight squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (light) - A
- Eight squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (dark) - B
- Sixteen squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (medium) - C
- Four squares $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (dark) - D

2. Create half square triangle blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of one light A square and place it on one medium C square; pin in place. Stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut in half and press toward C. Make sixteen medium half square triangle blocks.


3. Repeat Step 2 using remaining eight medium $C$ squares and eight dark B squares. Make sixteen dark half square triangle blocks.

4. Create block:

- Lay out medium half square triangles, dark half square triangles, and D squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Friendship Stars block measuring $12^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
