# Nancy's Notions Free Quilt Block Pattern 

## Block 9: Churn Dash Star

Use one light, one medium, and one dark fabric.


## Instructions:

Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut fabrics:

- Two squares $53 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (light) - A
- Two squares $53 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 538^{\prime \prime}$ (dark) - B
- Four rectangles 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " (light) - C
- Four squares $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ (dark) - D
- Eight squares 2" x 2 " (medium) - E
- One square $31 / 21 \times 31122^{\prime \prime}$ (medium) - F

2. Create half square triangle blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of one light A square and place it on one dark B square; pin in place. Stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut in half and press half square triangle toward B. Make four half square triangle blocks.


3. Create "house" blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner on wrong side of one medium E square and place it on top corner of one dark D square; pin in place. Stitch diagonally across E square. Trim corner to a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and press toward E. Repeat for remaining corner. Add one light C rectangle on opposite side. Press toward D. Make four "house" blocks.



## 4. Create block:

- Lay out half square triangle, "house", and F squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite directions. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Churn Dash Star block measuring $12 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square.
