## Missouri Star Quilt Block featuring "Chuck"

Follow the directions for Jenny's Missouri star quit block on the Missouri Star You tube channel- Click Here to make the Missouri star block. I modified the sized to make this block 16.5 " $\times 16.5$ " finished and to accommodate the Chuck template in the center. The fabric used is the exclusive Missouri Star "Quilt town" line

## Fabrics

- White- cut $1-71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Large Floral- Cut $1-71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Yellow print- cut 4-5" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ (corners)
- Dark Print - Cut $7-71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Light Print - Cut 1-7 1/2" $\times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Supplies

- Chuck Template
- Yellow Fabric 5" $\times 5$ "" square
- Heat $n$ bond lite $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ square
- Embroidery Thread- see colors below
- 6" or 7" Embroidery Hoop
- Stick \& Stitch or Tracing paper

- 310
- 726
- White
- 20
- 964
- 3824
- 959
- 722
- 3812


## To make Chuck:

- Following the manufactures instructions- Add heat n bond lite or feather lite to the back of yellow fabric
- Trace the Chuck template and cut out.
- Place in the center of the block and iron in place.
- Machine stitch using a blanket stitch or zig zag around the edge of Chuck to secure him in place.
- Embroidery the beak using a sating stitch and the eye using a single french knot.
- Trace the embroidery design onto stick \& stitch and place as desired.
- Embroider Using your favorite embroidery stitches and DMC floss.
- Rinse away solvy using warm water, let dry.

- Lazy Daisy
- Whipped Back Stitch
- French Knots
- Satin Stitch
- Straight Stitch
