"Incorporating the word 'dry' in the title seems a redundant qualifier given the almost exclusive Australian lean towards the dry and pale after so long with the sweet and lurid. No matter, this is certainly a pale pink, and fashionably so. It is relatively rich and fulsome of flavour on the palate, though dry, as stated. The flavours sit in the red berry, peach and pink apple skin zone with nice purity and zip allied with some generosity."
