

SIZES

Block: 12" x 12" finished (12-1/2" x 12-1/2"

unfinished)

Finished quilt size: 48" x 48"

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

This pattern assumes basic appliqué skills. There are many different appliqué techniques. The sample quilt was created using Fused Raw Edge Appliqué and this pattern shares instructions for that method.

NOTES

- Print the templates at 100% or "actual size".
 Each template page includes a 1" square. When printing, alway measure the square to ensure proper sizing.
- The pattern diagram (full picture) will not be to scale.
- Seam allowances are not included in the appliqué patterns. Please add a seam allowance if you wish to use a needle-turn or glue basted appliqué technique.

- Make sure to label the template pieces as they are traced. Many pieces are similar in shape and can be easily confused.
- A set of reversed templates have been provided for use with the Fused Raw Edge Appliqué method.
- This pattern is for personal use only.
 Mass production of this design is strictly prohibited.

MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES

Please note, this is only a guide. Feel free to experiment with color and fabric other than what has been recommended. Templates are labeled with the corresponding letter for the suggested color.

Fabric:

14" x 14" square of background fabric 1/8 yd Medium Green (E) 1/8 yd Dark Green (D) 1/8 yd Medium Gold (A) 1/8 yd Light Grey (C) 1/8 yd White (B)



Tweezers


January Pattern Templates
2022 Aurifil Color Builder: Frangipani
Fusible web
Sharp Detail Scissors (crucial for crisp and clean appliqué pieces)
Iron
Non-stick Ironing Sheet
Pen/pencil

INSTRUCTIONS: These steps are for fusible raw edge appliqué. If a different method of appliqué is desired, please consult the links shared above.


- 1. Cut background square to 14" x 14". This will allow for some wiggle room in case the background fabric undergoes shrinking during the fusing process. Block will be trimmed to size after fusing is complete.
- 2. Print reversed templates for use with the fusible appliqué method.
- 3. Trace the template shapes on to the smooth side of the fusible web. Make sure to label each piece to eliminate layout confusion. Cut each piece out, leaving a 1/4" margin around the traced line. The margin does not have to be exact.
- 4. To create appliqué pieces, place fusible side of the fusible web against the wrong side of the appliqué fabric and press according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Trim each of the shapes along the traced lines, leaving paper backing on the prepared pieces.
- 6. On the background fabric, build each individual bloom, overlapping and tucking petals as directed in the following steps. Start with the bottom bloom and proceed clockwise through the three remaining blooms. Remove backing papers after desired placement is achieved for each bloom. Tweezers are helpful for precise placement.
- 7. Place pieces in the following order for Bloom 1: 12B, 13B, 14B, 15B, 16B. (Figure 1)
- 8. Places pieces in the following order for Bloom 2: 4B, 5B, 6B, 2B, 3B. (Figures 2 & 3)



9. Place pieces in the following order for Bloom 3: 17B, 18B, 19B, 21C, 22C, 20B. (Figures 4 & 5) Tuck pointed end of bloom 3 under appliqué piece 2B in bloom 2 as shown.



10. Place pieces in the following order for Bloom 4: 11B, 7B, 8B, 9B, 10B. (Figures 6 & 7)





- 11. Once blooms are placed, assemble leaves as illustrated on the block diagram and tuck into place.
- 12. Tuck stem into place under Bloom 1 and add centers to each of the three primary blooms.
- 13. Fuse according to manufacturer's instructions, being careful to not shift pieces.
- 14. Square up and trim background fabric to 12-1/2" x 12-1/2".
- 15. Add decorative stitching as desired to further secure pieces to the background fabric.













Plumeria pudica templates
