

# **OFF-LICENCE RENEWAL**

*Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 - Section 135*

51/OF/028/2021

To **ABEL NEW ZEALAND LIMITED**

The **off-licence** in respect of the premises situated at **94 Flaxmore Road, Harakeke** and known as "**Abel New Zealand Limited**" is renewed.

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **ABEL NEW ZEALAND LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol from the premises situated at **94 Flaxmore Road, Harakeke** and known as "**Abel New Zealand Limited**" and deliver it somewhere else. This licence is endorsed under Section 40 of the Act.

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. The present conditions of the licence continue to apply. These are as follows:

## **CONDITIONS**

1. **HOURS:** Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day. Alcohol must not be delivered to the buyer between 11.00 pm and 6.00 am the next day, on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
2. **RESTRICTIONS:**
  - (a) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
  - (b) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol, sold by remote means, is not under the purchase age.
3. **SIGNAGE:** The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires must be displayed on any internet site for remote sales, in any catalogue and printed on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on
