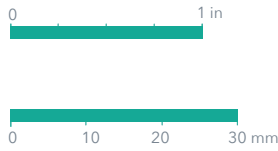


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

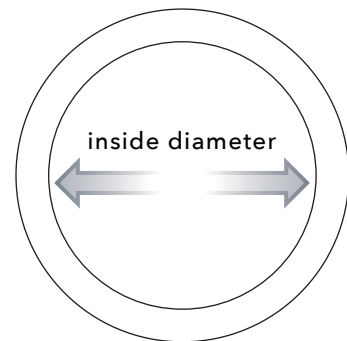
CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



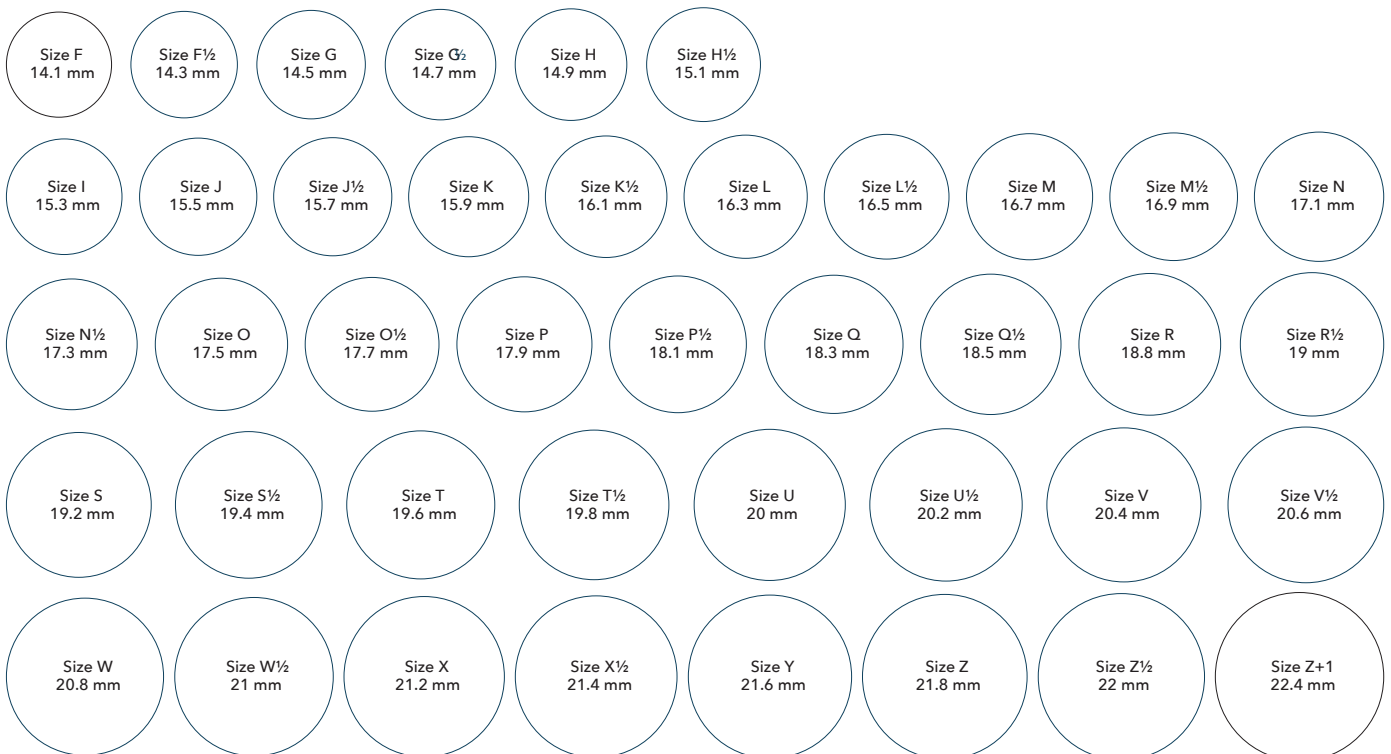
1. Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
2. Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. (To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
3. Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately, place a 20 cent piece where indicated. The coin should fit completely over the image so that all the lines are covered, without the coin hanging over any edges.

MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger
2. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
