


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE



- Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
- Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. (To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
- Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately, place a 20 cent piece where indicated. The coin should fit completely over the image so that all the lines are covered, without the coin hanging over any edges.

MEASURE CURRENT RING

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
