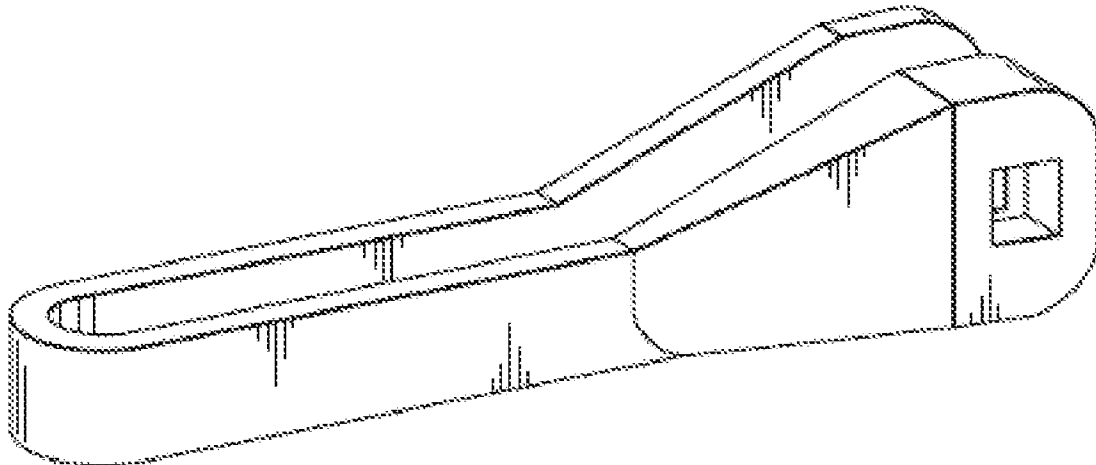

(57) **CLAIM**
I claim the ornamental design for a pocket key organizer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

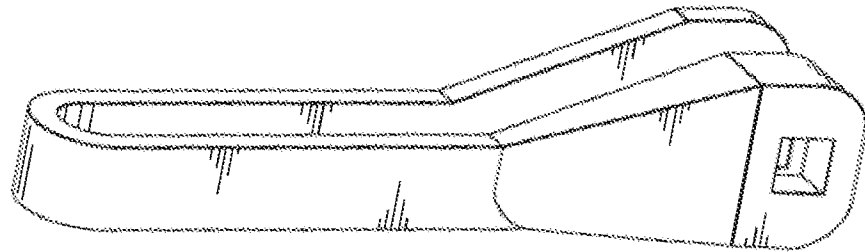

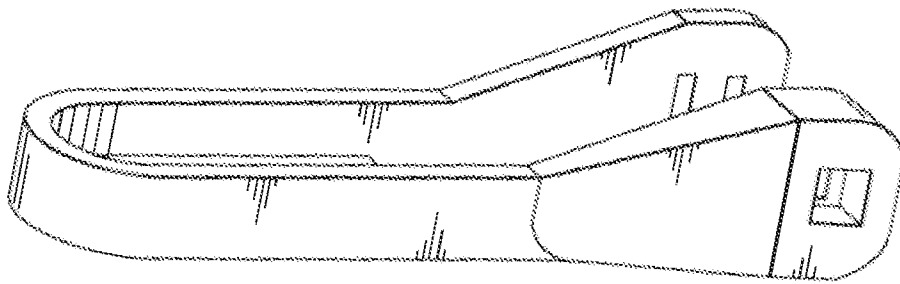

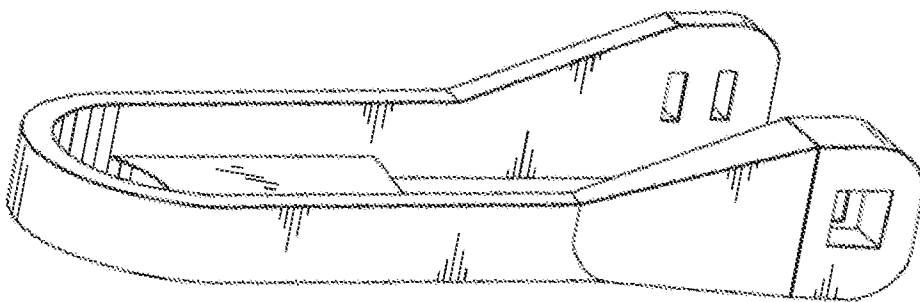

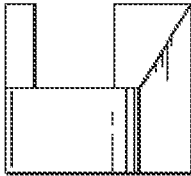

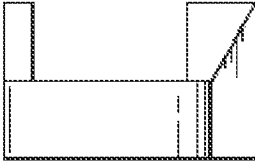

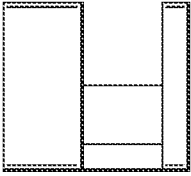

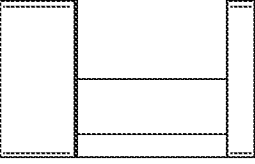

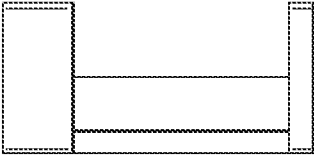

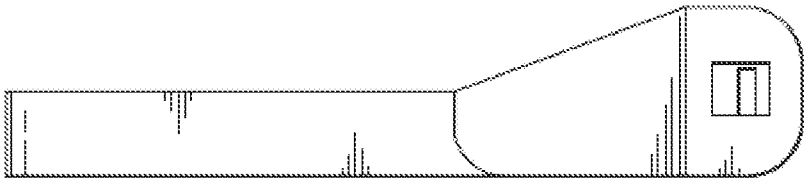

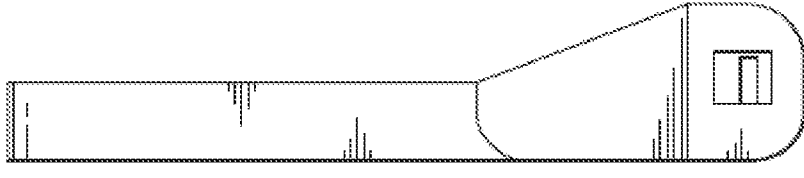

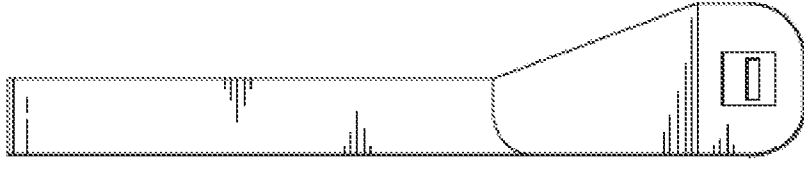

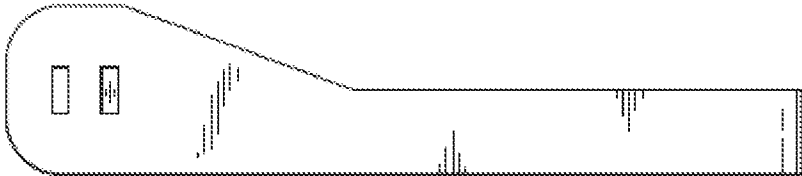

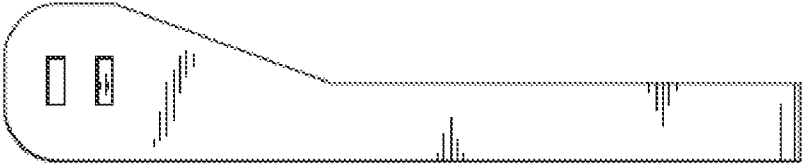

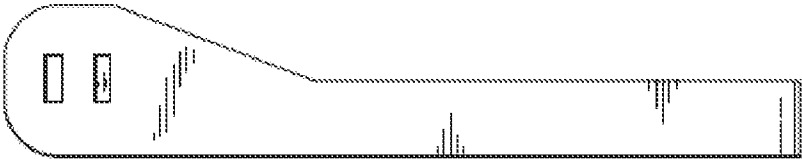

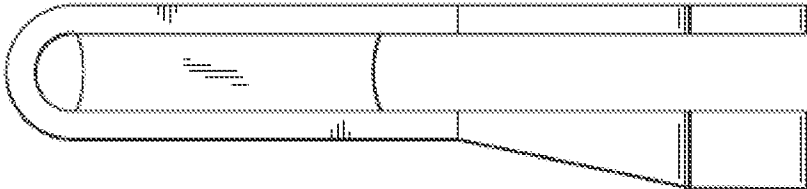

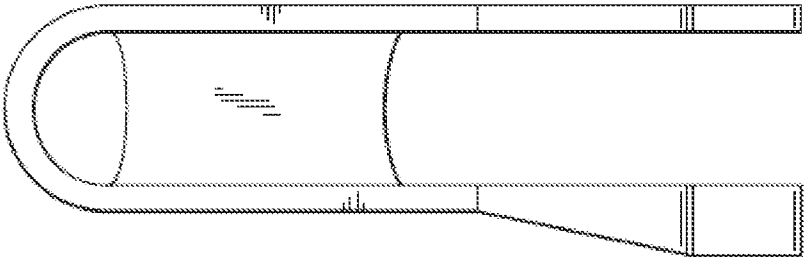

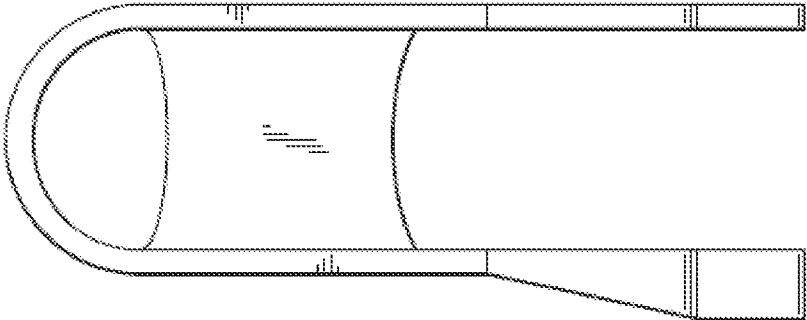

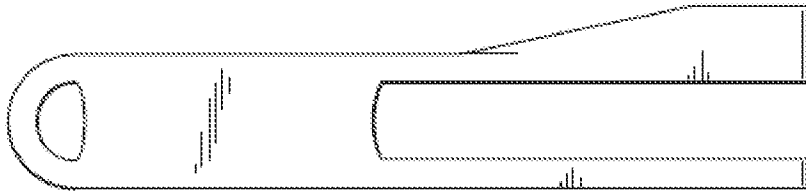

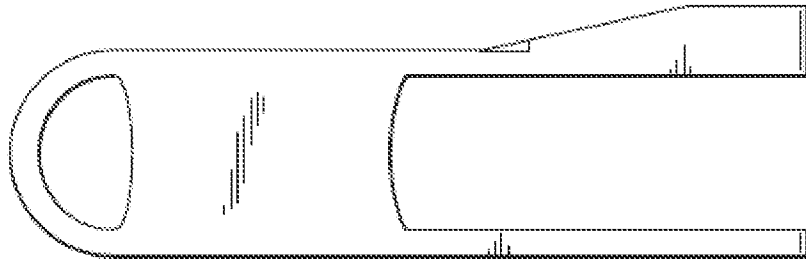

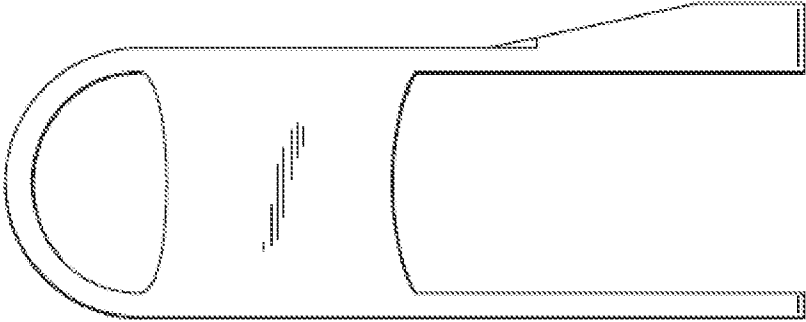

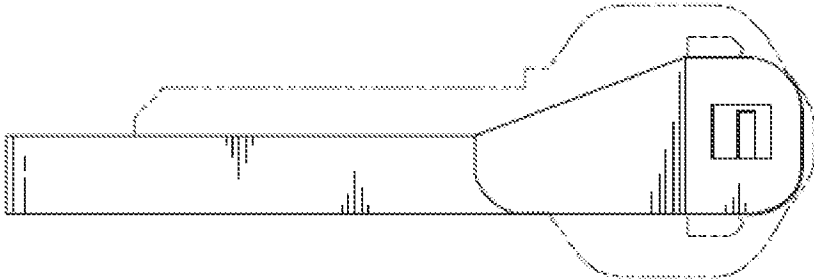

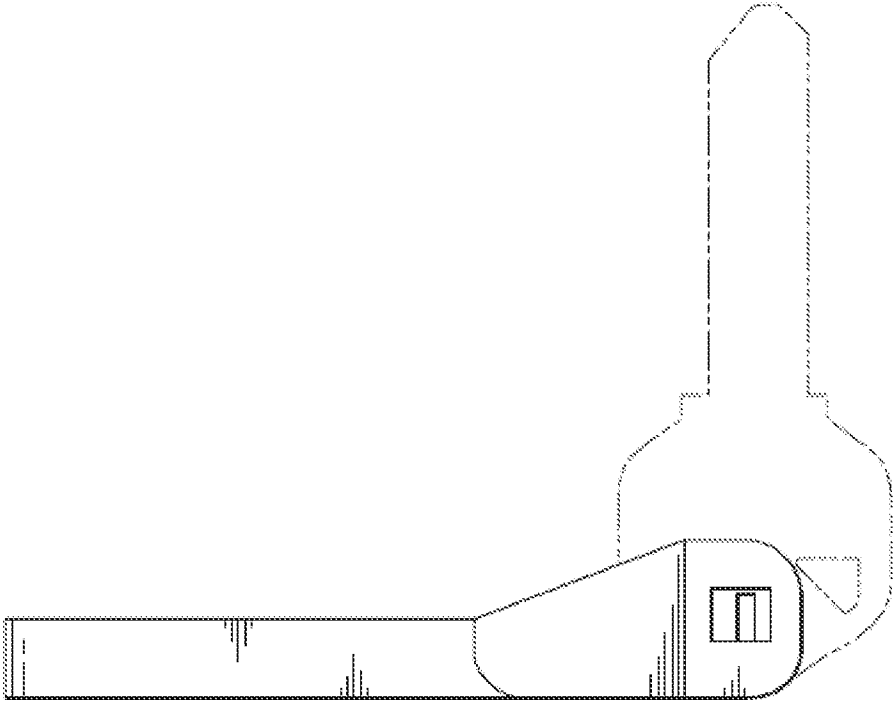
