

# Errata for Fussy Cut Sampler, First Printing

#### Block 12

Fabric D&E - (1) 4-1/2" squares for QST. \*\*You only need 2 of each if you are using a directional fabric that you do not want to rotate in your second QST block.

## Block 19

Fabric A - (2) 9-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangles

Fabric B - (2) 5-1/2" squares

\*if you've already cut the fabrics to the cut size in the book, you'll find you can still make a perfectly sized block, but the updated measurements here give you room to fussy cut, and will also mirror the directions for marking your ruler in the Tip.

#### Block 31

The cutting size for Fabric B should be (4) 6-1/2" x 2" rectangles

### Block 34

Fabric A

- (3) 4 1/2" squares for HSTs, cut once along the diagonal
- (3) 4" squares for the QSTs, cut once along the diagonal Fabric B
- (3) 4 1/2" squares for HSTs, cut once along the diagonal
- (2) 4" squares for the QSTs, cut once along the diagonal

### Block 37

The cutting directions on this block are correct if you are making a block that looks like Nichole's block (pg 110). Directions should read:

- Gather the Fabric B rectangles and Fabric C squares and assemble 4 B/C Flying Geese Units (see page 10). Trip to 2"x3.5". Repeat using Fabric C rectangles and Fabric B squares, assemble 4 C/B Flying Geese units. Set aside.
- Sew an assembled Fabric B/C unit from Step 1 to an assembled C/B unit also from step 1. Repeat to create a total of 4 units. Press and set aside.
- Sew a Fabric B square to a 2" fabric A square. Press, repeat to create a total of 4 units.

- Sew a fabric B rectangle to the bottom of an assembled unit from Step 3. press. Repeat to create a total of 4 units.
- Sew an assembled unit from Step 4 to either side of an assembled unit from Step 4 to either side of an assembled unit from Step 2. Repeat and press.
- Sew an assembled unit from Step 2 to either side of the 3.5" Fabric A square. Press.
- · Sew the rows together and press.
