- This 12V camp light kit is designed for use in sheltered areas, and should be protected from adverse weather. Any uses other than those mentioned in this manual will be considered a case of misuse. The user shall be liable for any damage or injury resulting from such cases of misuse.
- To use the 12V camp light properly you must observe the installation instructions to be found in this manual.
- Children should be supervised at all times whilst operating the camp light kit.
- Be cautious when connecting cables to a power source as this may cause injuries when it is not carried out correctly.
- DO NOT look directly at this light as it can cause eye damages.
- This product is designed to be connected to a 12V system.
- To disconnect the cord, DO NOT drag the cord itself. Doing so may result in damage to the cord, leading to fire or electric shock.
- A maximum of 8x50cm LED bars can be used in one circuit. Any additional bars may cause overheating and damage to the items/circuits.

INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly:

Step 1: Both ends of the camping light bar are equipped with magnets that will securely stick to the metal surfaces. Or using the Velcro tapes the LED bars can be attached to any of the horizontal or vertical alloy poles. Ensure that the cables are neatly tucked away by cables ties.

Step 2: Connect your 12v cigarette connector to an output, or connect it to the battery clamp to cigarette adapter for battery connection.

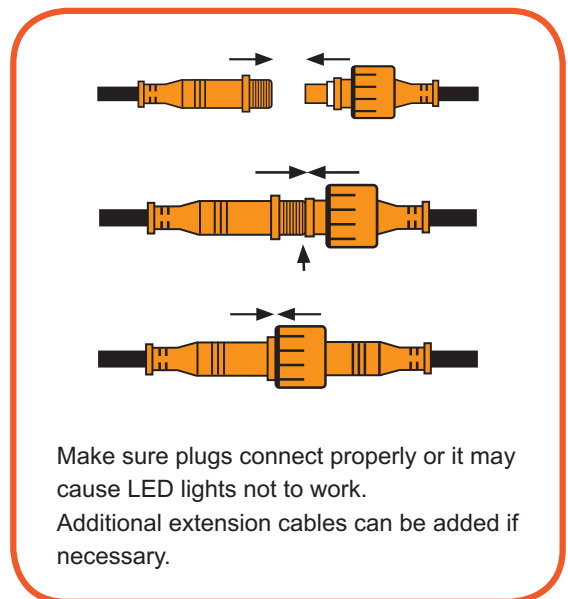
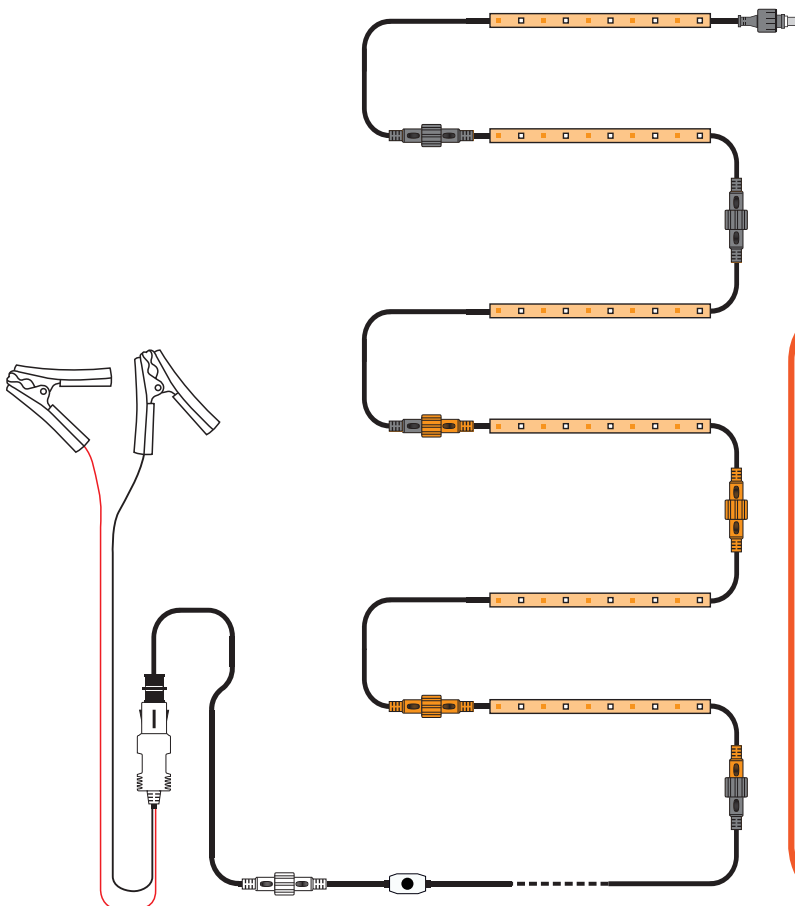
Step 3: And finally from here it is all up to you! You can either extend the kit with extension cables, or finally your camping light bars according to your campsite.

TYPICAL CAMPER INSTALLATION:

The diagram serves as a reference ONLY.

Below are the 12V light bars with extension cables.

You do not have to follow this diagram, you can place the bars and cables wherever you like to suit your setup!



TROUBLESHOOTING

Q: Can my camp light kit run on 110V / 240V power outlet?

A: Yes, but you need to purchase a transformer if you wish to power your kit from 110V / 240V power.

Q: What should I do if my lights don't work?

A: Check whether connections are secure and ensure that the power supply is plugged in and switched on. Some vehicle cigarette sockets can have loosefitting connections. Try to push the cigarette plug in further. If it still does not work you will need to use a different power source. You can connect directly to the battery using the supplied alligator clamps.

If it is still not working, try unplugging the On/Off switch and connecting the LED directly to the power source. If it now works you have located a problem in the On/Off switch.

If you are still experiencing difficulties after following these steps, please contact our customer center.

Q: How many light bars can I run?

A: You can run up to 8 light bars.

Q: Can I run these lights off a generator?

A: Yes, you can connect them to a generator using a transformer.

Q: What do I do if some lights work and some don't?

A: You may have a faulty lead. Please check the light directly from the cigarette or transformer lead. If all lights are working, please test each cord between the light and power until you find the faulty cord.
