1 pair 4 mm (UK 8 – USA 6) knitting needles

Tension

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, 4 in over stocking-stitch using 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. Check your tension – if less stitches use thinner needles, if more use thicker needles.

Little College Jersey

BACK

Using 3¼ mm needles and thumb method cast on 66[74:78:86:90] sts.

1st row. * K2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

2nd row. * P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

These 2 rows are called **2x2 rib**. Work 5[5:7:7:7] rows more in rib. Change to 4 mm needles.

Next row. K4[4:2:3:8], k2tog, (k6[5:6:5:6], k2tog) 7[9:9:11:9] times, k4[5:2:4:8].

58[64:68:74:80] sts.

Knit 2 rows.



1st row. Knit.

2nd row. Purl.

These 2 rows are called **st-st** (stocking-stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 16[19:24:27:30] cm, 6¼[7½:9½:10¾:11¾] in, ending with a ws row. **

Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 3[4:5:5:7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 52[56:58:64:66] sts. Work 28[30:32:34:36] rows dec 1 st at each end of 1st and every foll alt row. 24[26:26:30:30] sts. Leave rem 24[26:26:30:30] sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Next row. Cast off 3[4:5:5:7] sts, knit to end. 55[60:63:69:73] sts.

Next row. Cast off 3[4:5:5:7] sts, p25[27:28:31:32], m1, purl to end. 53[57:59:65:67] sts.

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 51[55:57:63:65] sts.

Next row. P25[27:28:31:32], k1, p25[27:28:31:32].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 49[53:55:61:63] sts.

Next row. P23[25:26:29:30], k3, p23[25:26:29:30].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 47[51:53:59:61] sts.

Next row. P21[23:24:27:28], k5, p21[23:24:27:28].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 45[49:51:57:59] sts.

Next row. P19[21:22:25:26], k7, p19[21:22:25:26].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 43[47:49:55:57] sts.

Next row. P17[19:20:23:24], k9, p17[19:20:23:24].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 41[45:47:53:55] sts.

Next row. P15[17:18:21:22], k11, p15[17:18:21:22].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 39[43:45:51:53] sts.

Next row. P13[15:16:19:20], k13, p13[15:16:19:20].

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41:43:49:51] sts.

Next row. P[13:14:17:18], k15, p[13:14:17:18].

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. [39:41:47:49] sts.

Next row. P[11:12:15:16], k17, p[11:12:15:16].

For 4th and 5th sizes only

Next row. K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. [45:47] sts.

Next row. P[13:14], k19, p[13:14].

For 5th size only

1st row. K1, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.
 2nd row. P1, * k2, p2, rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, p1.
 These 2 rows form rib.
 Work 5[5:7:7:7] rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neck band seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Placing hood borders at centre of front neck, sew hood evenly in position along the pick-

up row on the inside of the neck band, gathering in any fullness. Pin out sweater to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

1 pair of 4 mm (USA 6 – UK 8) knitting needles
 1 pair 3¼ mm (USA 3 – UK 10) knitting needles for Boat and Heart Bibs, Booties and Shoes.
 Stitch holders for Bibs and Shoes
 1 Button for each bib,
 2 Buttons for shoes.

Tension

See tension at the beginning of each pattern. Check your tension – if less stitches use thinner needles, if more use thicker needles.

Little Dribble Bib

TENSION

20 sts and 40 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over garter stitch on 4 mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 1 st.

Next row. Knit into front, back



and front of st. 3 sts.

Next row. Inc in 1st st, k1, inc in last st. 5 sts.

Next row. K1, (inc in next st) twice, k2. 7 sts.

Work as follows:

Next row. Knit.

This row is called **g-st** (garter stitch).

Next row. K1, inc in next st, knit to last 3 sts, inc in next st, k2. 9 sts.

Last row forms increases.

Work 52 rows inc 1 st at each end **as before** in 2nd and every foll alt row. 61 sts.

Work 12 rows inc 1 st at each end **as before** in 4th and every foll 4th row. 67 sts.

Work 2 rows more without shaping.

Cast off knitways.

TO COMPLETE

Make a button loop and attach to side edge of cast-off edge. Sew on button to opposite side to correspond with button loop. See ball band for further washing and care instructions.

Little Boat Bib

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 3¼ mm needles and thumb method cast on 39 sts.

1st row. Knit.

This row is called **g-st** (garter stitch).

Work 5 rows more in g-st.

Sockies (throughout) work as follows:
1st row. Inc in 1st st, knit to last 2 sts, inc in next st, k1. 10[12:14] sts.
2nd row. Purl.
Toe shaping



Work 6[8:8] rows inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 16[20:22] sts.

Upper shaping

With rs facing, inc in 1st st 1[0:0] times, k5[8:9], turn and leave rem 10[12:13] sts on a holder. 7[8:9] sts.

Work on these 7[8:9] sts as follows:

Next row. P2tog, purl to end. 6[7:8] sts.

Next row. Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 5[6:7] sts.

Work 12[12:14] rows more

Heel shaping

Next row. P2tog, purl to end. 4[5:6] sts.

Next row. Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 3[4:5] sts.

Cast off rem 3[4:5] sts purlways.

With rs facing, rejoin M to rem 10[12:13] sts, cast off 4 sts, knit to last 2[0:0] sts, (inc in next st, k1) 1[0:0] times. 7[8:9] sts.

Next row. Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 6[7:8] sts.

Next row. K2tog, knit to end. 5[6:7] sts.

Work 12[12:14] rows more without shaping.

Heel Shaping

Next row. Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 4[5:6] sts.

Next row. K2tog, knit to end. 3[4:5] sts.

Cast off rem 3[4:5] sts purlways.

Upper Edging

With rs facing, using 3¼ mm needles and C, starting at inside of heel edge, pick up and knit 13[15:15] sts along straight edge, 7 sts around shaped edge and 13[15:15] sts evenly along other straight edge. 33[37:37] sts.

** **Next row.** Knit.

Next row. *K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last st, k1.

Strap for Left Shoe

Join heel seam. With rs facing, using 3¼ mm needles and C, cast on 16[18:20] sts for strap, beg and ending 4[4.5:4.5] cm, 1½[1¾:1¾] in each side of heel seam, pick up and knit 17[19:21] sts from cast-off edge, then cast on 16[18:20] sts for strap. 33[37:41] sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Upper Edging.

Strap for Right Shoe

Using 3¼ mm needles and C, cast on 16[18:20] sts for strap then with rs facing, beg and ending 4[4.5:4.5] cm, 1½[1¾:1¾] in each side of heel seam, pick up and knit 17[19:21] sts from cast-off edge. 33[37:41] sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Upper Edging.

TO MAKE UP

Join heel seam. With seam at centre of heel on the sole, sew upper part of shoe evenly all around the sole. Sew on buttons using eyelet in the strap for buttonholes. See ball band for further washing and care instructions.

Slouchy Fair Isle Beanie

Tension

23 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm over patt on 4 mm needles.

Using 3¼ mm needles, yarn A and thumb method cast on 85[89:91:95:99] sts.

1st row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

2nd row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form **1x1 rib**.

Change to yarn B and work 7 rows more in rib 0[0:inc:inc:inc] 0[0:2:2:2] sts evenly across last row. 85[89:93:97:101] sts.

Work as given for Fairisle Beret from ** to **.

18th row. Using yarn B, purl to end.



These 18 rows form **patt**.

Cont in patt until Hat measures approximately 15[15:15:16:16] cm, 6[6:6:6¼:6¼] in ending with patt row 4, 10 or 16.

Next row. K to end dec[inc:dec:inc:dec] 3[2:2:3:1] sts evenly across row 82[91:91:100:100] sts.

Next row. Purl.

Shape Top

Working in in st-st in stripe sequence of 2 rows C, 2 rows A and 2 rows B, proceed as

follows:

1st row. (K7[8:8:9:9], k2tog) 9 times, k1. 73[82:82:91:91] sts.

2nd row. Purl.

3rd row. (K6[7:7:8:8], k2tog) 9 times, k1. 64[73:73:82:82] sts.

4th row. Purl.

5th row. (K5[6:6:7:7], k2tog) 9 times, k1. 55[64:64:73:73] sts.

6th row. Purl.

7th row. (K4[5:5:6:6], k2tog) 9 times, k1. 46[55:55:64:64] sts.

8th row. Purl.

Cont in this way, dec 9 sts on next and every foll alt row, until the foll row has been worked:

Next row. (K1, k2tog) 9 times, k1. 19 sts.

Next row. P1, (p2tog) 9 times. Break yarn and thread through rem 10 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. Lay hat out flat. Cover with a clean, damp tea towel and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

Using 3¼ mm needles and thumb method cast on 55[59:65:71:75] sts.

1st row. Knit.

This row forms **g-st**.

Work in g-st for a further 11[11:11:13:13] rows, ending with a ws row.

Change to 4 mm needles.

Now work in patt as follows:

1st row. Knit.

2nd row. K0[1:0:1:0], p2[3:1:3:0], * k3, p3, rep from * to last 5[1:4:1:3] sts, k3[1:3:1:3],

k2tog, (k25[27:29:18:20],

k2tog) 2[2:2:4:4] times,

k10[12:14:9:10].

73[81:89:95:105] sts.

Break off C, join in M.

Change to 4 mm needles and work as follows:

1st row. Knit.

2nd row. Purl.

Last 2 rows form **st-st** (stocking

stitch). Cont in st-st until back

measures 15[17:23:30:34] cm,

6[6½:9:11¾:13½] in, ending with a ws row.

Next row (decrease row for bodice). K7[8:6:9:8], k2tog, (k1, k2tog) 19 [21:25:25:29] times, k7[8:6:9:8]. 53[59:63:69:75] sts.

Next row. Purl.

Cont without shaping until back measures 18[20:26:34:38] cm, 7[8:10¼:13½:15] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Raglan

Cast off 4[4:5:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 45[51:53:59:65] sts. **

For 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th sizes only

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at each end of 1st row only.

43[49:51:57] sts.

For all sizes

Work 24[26:28:30:38] rows

dec 1 st at each end of

next and every foll alt row.

19[23:23:27:27] sts.

Cast off rem 19[23:23:27:27] sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm needles, thumb method and C, cast on 41[45:50:54:59] sts.

Work 3 rows in g-st as given for Back.

4th row. K9[11:12:10:11],

k2tog, (k19[19:21:14:15],

k2tog) 1[1:1:2:2] times,

k9[11:13:10:12].

39[43:48:51:56] sts.

Break off C, join in M.

Change to 4 mm needles and work as follows:

1st row. Knit.

2nd row. K4[4:5:5:5], purl to end.

1st and 2nd rows form **st-st with g-st front border**.

Cont until left front measures

15[17:23:30:34] cm,

6[6½:9:11¾:13½] in, ending with a ws row.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at raglan edge in 1st row only.

24[27:29:32] sts.

For all sizes

Work 17[19:19:21:29] rows

dec 1 st at raglan edge in

next and every foll alt row.

Shape Neck

Next row. Cast off 6[8:8:10:10] sts, purl to end. 9[9:11:11:11] sts.

Work 4[4:5:5:5] rows dec 1 st at

row. 3 sts.

26.5 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm over patt on 4½ mm needles. Using 3¾ mm needles and thumb method, cast on 172 sts.

1st row. K1, * k2, p2, rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

2nd row. P1, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

These 2 rows form **rib**.

Work 13 rows more in rib.

Next row. P4, p2tog, (p5, p2tog) 23 times, p5. 148 sts.

Change to 4½ mm needles.

1st row. P2, * p1, k2, (p2, k6) twice, p2, k2, p1, ** rep from * to ** 5 times more, p2.

2nd row. K2, * k1, p2, (k2, p6) twice, k2, p2, k1, ** rep from * to ** 5 times more, k2.

3rd row. P2, * p1, k2, p2, C6F, p2, C6B, p2, k2, p1, ** rep from * to ** 5 times more, p2.

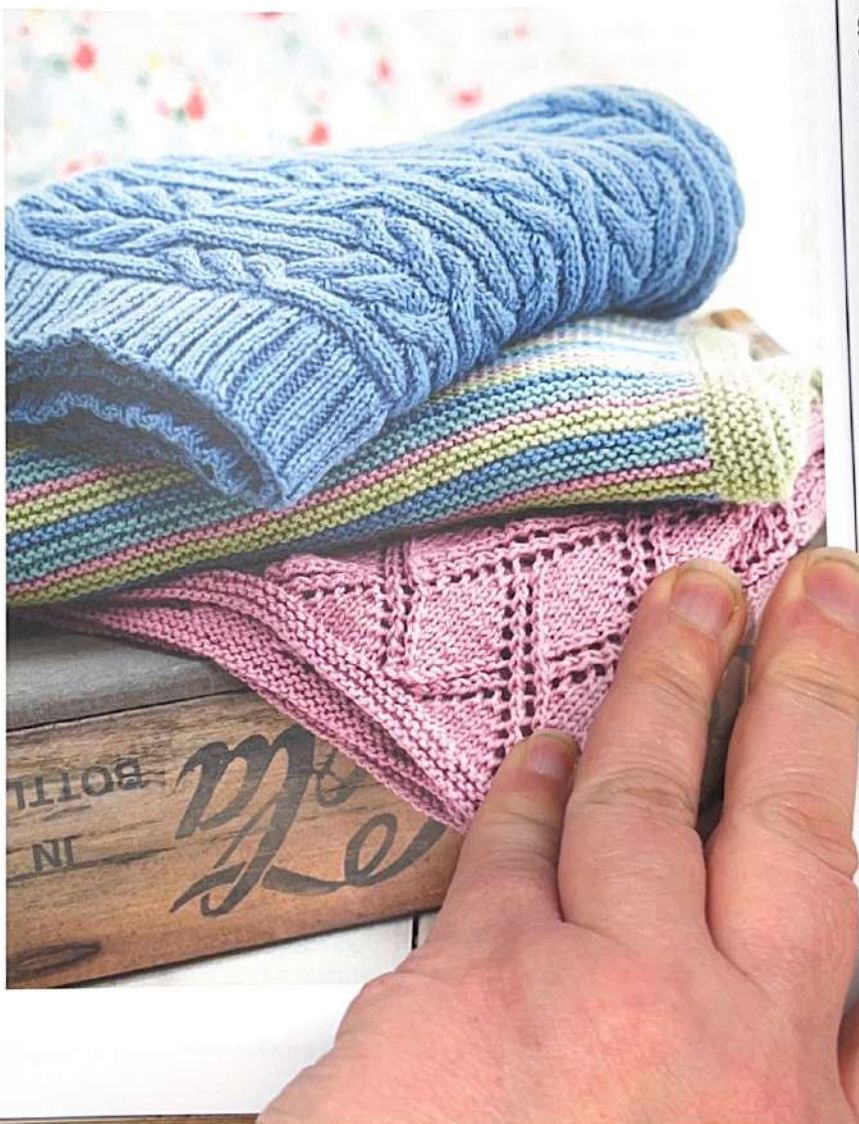
4th row. As 2nd row.

5th row. As 1st row.

6th row. As 2nd row.

7th to 18th row. Rep 1st to 6th rows twice more.

19th row. P2, * p1, k6, (p2, k2)



Cast off (on ws).

SIDE BORDERS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using 4 mm needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 8 sts evenly along rib, 136 sts evenly along side edge and 8

sts evenly along rib. 152 sts. Work 8 rows in g-st. Cast off (on ws).

TO FINISH

Pin out blanket to the measurements given. Cover with a clean, damp tea towel and

leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
