



Work 12[8:8:16:12] rows dec 1 st at each end of 1st and every foll 4th row. 42[50:54:54:60] sts. Work 20[26:30:26:32] rows dec 1 st at each end of 1st and every foll alt row. 22[24:24:28:28] sts. Cast off rem 22[24:24:28:28] sts.
