For ages:

0-3; 3-6; 6-12 mths; 1-2 & 2-3 years

To fit:

16", 18", 20", 22", 24"

[40, 45, 50, 55, 60cm] chest.

Actual size 18", 20", 22", 24", 26"

[45, 50, 55, 60, 65cm]

The instructions for the larger sizes
will appear in brackets.

Tension:

29 stitches, 56 rows to 4" (10cm) square.

Materials:

150, 150, (200), (200), (250) gms of Opal 4-ply sock yarn.

One pair 3.00mm needles for first size and 2.75 mm needles for all the larger sizes throughout.

To fit 16'' 18'' 20''

Chest 41cm 46cm 51cm

You will need

Yarn: 100g 100gm 200gm

Opal 4ply sock yarn

2.75mm and 3.25mm needles

2 small buttons

Tension

28st and 36 rows to 10cm using 3.25mm needles.

Baby's Domino Cardigan

Sizes: The smallest size based on 27 sts per square will fit a new-born. Increasing the number of sts per square by 2 will add 2.5cm to the chest and length. The instructions for the larger sizes will appear in brackets

Tension: Each square starting with 27 sts and measures 5.5cm each way

Materials: 100 gms Opal sock yarn for first two sizes, 200gms will be needed for larger sizes. Needle size: 3mm

To Fit:

Up to 6 months

Materials:

100gms of Opal 4-ply sock yarn

A pair of 3mm needles and 6 buttons

Tension:

56 rows and 27 sts to 10cms working in garter stitch.

Baby Jumper

Needles required

3mm and 3.25mm needles

6 buttons

Tension

28st and 36 rows to 10cm using 3.25mm needles.

Tips for pattern matching pieces. When casting on always start at a point in the yarn pattern repeat that is easy to spot. When casting on the piece you would like to match wind off yarn until you reach that easy to identify point in the repeat and then cast on at that same point

Tension:

30sts and 42 rows to 10cm square using 3.00mm needles for hat.

32sts and 44rows to 10cm square using 2.5mm needles for mittens.

Materials:

100 gms Opal 4ply sock yarn



Baby Hat, Socks and Mitts

Needles required

3mm Double Pointed Needles (DPN's)

Yarn Required

100gms Opal 4ply sock yarn (more than enough to complete a couple of sets)

Tension

27st and 34 rows to 10cm using 3mm needles.
