

The simple stitches of this pattern make it a good choice to showcase multi-colour yarns such as Yarns from Heaven Logan, Malabrigo Rasta, or Berroco Coco.

This super-bulky yarn project is suitable for beginner knitters who know the knit and purl stitches.



SUPER BULKY



Easy / Facile / Fácil

What you need to make this cowl

- 250g Super-bulky yarn.
 - Yarns from Heaven Logan
 - Malabrigo Rasta
- Circular needle size 10mm (US 15) with a cord length 60cm (24 inches)
- Darning needle with jumbo eye to weave in the ends



Gauge

7 stitches = 10cm (4") in 2x2 rib

Instructions

1. Using a stretchy cast on, cast on 52 stitches.
2. Join in the round, being careful to make sure that all of your stitches are pointed in the same direction. It's important not to twist the stitches when you join.
3. Knit 2, Purl 2 to end of round.
4. Repeat step 3 until the cowl is the desired height, or until you're nearly out of yarn.
5. Using a stretchy bind off, bind off all stitches.
6. Decide which side is the right side and which side is the wrong side, and weave in the yarn ends on the wrong side.
