FREE PATTERN

Cameo Ruffle Scarf

Knit Version: (shown)

Finished measurements:

Approximately 6" wide & 44" long.

Materials:

1 ball Estelle Frill Seeker Cameo

1 pair 10mm straight needles (sharp tips are best)

Method

To cast on, unroll an 8" length from the ball. Working along the long edge of the piece, starting about 2" up from the end, insert the needle into the edge of the piece, from front to back, to pick up a "stitch". Repeat this twice more, spacing the stitches out by about an inch.

Work as follows:

Knit the third stitch, pulling up the edge of the fabric and wrapping it around the needle and pulling it through, leaving the stitch on the left needle. Knit the first stitch in the same manner, slipping the stitch off the left needle; knit the second stitch, and slip both the second and third stitches off the needle.

Turn, and repeat until about 6 inches of the fabric remain.

Note: As you work, stretch the fabric widthwise and let the scarf twist around itself.

To cast off, knit the first stitch and then the second, and lift the first stitch over the second; knit the third stitch and lift it over the second. Pull the end of the fabric strip through the final stitch to secure.

Tie an overhand knot in the loose end of the fabric at the cast-on end, to secure it.

Optional, for an infinity scarf: using a smooth yarn, seam the cast on and cast off edges together.

Crochet Version: Makes 2 scarves (not shown)

Finished measurements:

Approximately 5" wide & 44" long.

Materials:

1 ball Estelle Frill Seeker Cameo

1 3.5mm Crochet Hook

Method

To start, tuck raw edge of one end in approx 1.5". Insert crochet hook into one corner and work across narrow end of yarn through all layers. Bring hook over yarn and through all layers again. Bring through first loop (make a chain st). Continue across narrow edge and work down long edge of Cameo (pick up 3 or 4 threads for each chain) placing sts approx 2" apart. When close to opposite end, pull out a thread approx 10" long. Tuck the raw edge in as before, and crochet across narrow edge. Make one chain on opposite long end. Double the thread in half, pick up the thread with the hook and draw through last st. Finish off by pulling thread through the loop and fasten off. Weave in the end of the thread.
