

DOING OUR PART

CDC CLOTH MASK:



MATERIALS:

Two 10"x6" rectangles of cotton fabric

Two 6" pieces of elastic

Needle & thread

Scissors

Sewing machine

TUTORIAL:

- 1. Cut two 10x6 in. rectangles of cotton fabric. Use tightly woven cotton, such as quilting fabric or cotton sheets. Stack two rectangles.
- 2. Fold over long sides 1/4 in. & hem. Fold the double layer of fabric over 1/2 in. along the short sides & stitch down.
- 3. Run 6-in. length of 1/8-in. wide elastic through wider hem on each side of mask. These will be the ear loops. Use a large needle/bobby pin to thread through. Tie the ends tight.
- 4. Gently pull on elastic so knots are tucked inside hem. Gather sides of the mask on the elastic & adjust so mask fits your face. Securely stitch elastic in place to keep from slipping.






KEEPING CUSTOMERS & TEAM MEMBERS SAFE
