Porters is a style of beer that was first created in the early 18th century in London, England. Porters were dark and easy to brew and hid imperfections. London's water was too alkaline for lighter beers so Porters were a good alternative due to their stronger and bolder flavours. At the time, pub owners struggled to keep up with production so they would purchase beer from larger breweries which helped create commercial brewing as we see it now. Oatmeal is added to the brew and then the beer is nitrogenated prior to pouring to give it a full creamy mouthfeel and silky tan head.
