

Building your own framing for Wall Panel

For easiest installation, consult a licensed professional to evaluate your space before purchase. Your walls and ceiling will determine what type of anchors and additional hardware needed. Project Playroom Rock Wall Panels are intended to be used with our bolt-on Rock Wall Holds.

Tools and Materials

- Drill
- Studfinder
- 2x4 lumber
- Anchors for your wall type
- · Circular Saw
- Level
- Pencil
- Project Playroom Rock Wall Panels (no-frame)
- Project Playroom (Bolt-on) Rock Wall Holds and Bolts

Instructions:

- 1. Measure and cut the 2x4 ledgers to the length you need based on the size and layout of your climbing wall
- 2. Use studfinder to locate at least two studs per panel width
- 3. Attach ledger to studs using specifies anchors. We recommend starting with bottom ledger
- 4. Measure for placement of all remaining ledgers and install
- 5. Pre-drill all corners, this prevents paint from chipping
- 6. Mount panels to ledgers using wood screws included with your panels
 - o Optional- finish sides of wall with trim to 'hide' the ledger for a clean, finished look
- 7. Layout rock wall holds and begin to install
- 8. Hand tighten only; using a drill can damage the wall
- 9. Ensure the area is clear of landing hazards and protected with pads

Pro-tip: Get creative with you climbing route! Remember, you can make it easier or more challenging as your kids grow!
