EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH

Ritu Gill

How did you find out about Frontier Heritage?

The very first time that I heard of Frontier Heritage was from Mindy Kaling's Instagram page, where she had tagged Frontier because she wore one of their outfits on her show. A couple years later, I was excited to discover that Frontier had a Toronto location, which I found out about at the Kismet Wedding Show. After talking to Ishan at their booth and seeing their ready made outfits on display, I became very interested in going in store and finding out if they were the right fit for me.

Tell us about your experience at Frontier Heritage, starting with Customer Service.

What I liked most about the customer service at Frontier Heritage was how they provided me with peace of mind. It was the number one reason that I decided to go with Frontier Heritage for my wedding lenghas. From the moment that I walked into the store, they knew and remembered who I was, had my appointments ready to go, and acted like all my needs and desires were very important. Everyone made me feel very welcome, and made me feel like they would do anything to help. In fact, I made a personal connection with my personal assistant at the store, who truly made me feel like all my needs for my wedding lenghas would be met. She was absolutely amazing at reducing my stress, making suggestions for my lenghas, and just generally being such a sweet and caring person – which really helps during such a stressful period in your life!

Did you find what you were looking for?

I was able to find exactly what I was looking for. For both my lenghas, I walked into the store knowing exactly what I wanted. This can make shopping very discouraging and difficult. But at Frontier, they were able to completely deliver. My ceremony lengha was made completely from scratch with my exact vision in mind. They were able to incorporate the colours, embroidery and every detail that I wanted. For my reception lengtha, they happened to have something in stock which was very close to exactly what I had envisioned, and I was able to customize it to exactly what I wanted. Furthermore, my lenghas fit exceptionally, as they were able to make any necessary adjustments in store once my lenghas arrived from India.



How did the custom order process work for

When I started my order process, I knew exactly what I wanted in both my ceremony and reception lenghas. That's why it was very important to me that I could completely customize my order. When I had my first appointment, I tried on a number of lenghas to get a feel for the quality of the fabric and embroidery, different designs, and make sure that I was set on the design that I had wanted. After that, I went over exactly what I wanted for a few hours with my assistant at Frontier. She drew out the exact lenghas that I wanted, made suggestions on and pointed out any details that I was missing, and we obtained swatches of multiple fabrics to find the perfect colour and fabric for both lenghas. While the lenghas were being stitched, I was able to see pictures of the

What was your favourite part about the whole process?

My favourite part of the whole process was definitely trying on lenghas, and going over in detail exactly what I wanted in both. When I tried on the length that very closely resembled my reception length, I was almost in tears. I felt so relieved and happy that what I had envisioned could be actualized, and that the fact that they already had something so similar in stock would make the stitching easier. Going into detail about exactly what I wanted in both lenghas also put my mind at ease, because I knew that we had gone over every possibility for the details, and so I would

be getting exactly what I wanted.

Did we make your wedding experience easier? If yes, how?

Frontier Heritage made my wedding experience easier for two big reasons. First of all, I was able to have piece of mind about my wedding lenghas. After I had heard so many horror stories about brides not receiving their custom made lenghas in time, it was very important to me to order my lenghas from a reliable source. The customer service, friendly staff, and quality of product made me feel at ease making such a large investment at Frontier. And second, I was able to order both my products and many of the things my husband needed for our ceremony from Frontier. This saved me time, and ensured we both had high quality outfits and accessories for our big day.

Did you get anything else from Frontier other than your Wedding Dress?

We were able to buy a few items on my list from Frontier Heritage, which made the whole shopping process easier. In addition to my ceremony and reception lenghas, my mom also bought two completely custom made outfits for the ceremony and reception, which both turned out beautifully. What advice would you give to new Brides shopping for their big day?

The advice that I would give brides shopping

In the short term, I was happy that I ordered from Frontier because they put my mind at ease with providing a high quality and reliable service. How did you find out about Frontier Heritage?



Did you find what you were looking for?

Absolutely! The team at Frontier Heritage listened to my vision for my wedding outfits. They were very knowledgeable about the latest trends, what was going to look best on me, and which colors were going to set off my features as well. Also, being able to custom make my outfits was a total bonus.



The custom order process was great because it allowed me to put all of my visions together encompassed in one outfit. I had a particular style top in mind for my Sangeet outfit and Frontier had no problem executing it. The vision for my reception gown was the most rewarding. I found a gown with beautiful gold detail and I fell in love. It started off very bulky and unflattering; it wasn't even the color I wanted. I was extremely nervous of the outcome of the gown since it was not something I was going to see until a couple months before the wedding. The end product was absolutely stunning! What was your favourite part about the whole process?

My favorite part of the whole process was how attentive everyone was with my family and I. Being from Detroit, we all drove to Toronto for only two days of wedding shopping. It was important to get all of our shopping done in a timely manner while also choosing the most beautiful outfits. Although there were many other people in the store, we were taken care of and every need of ours was met.

Yes! Never having worn Indian clothes, I had

How did you find out about Frontier Heritage?

How did the custom order process work for you?

They made it very easy - they drew me a sketch, showed me colour swatches, emboirdary types, blouse cut and styles. They paid alot of attention to detail, I felt like I was designer for the day! I was in a time crunch as we planned our wedding in just six months! I believe I changed my lengha on them three times, coming in each week to alter something. Not once, did they get upset or impatient. They understood how important a bride's outfit is and just how crucial it was for me to be happy with it. I was a bit nervous, but they sent me picture updates every step of the way so I could relax and keep calm and bride on.

What was your favourite part about the whole process?

Everything they said and promised came true. My bridal lengha came on time and turned out more beautiful than I imagined. It was truly perfect. I also loved (and truly miss) how we became a part of their family.

Did we make your wedding experience easier? If yes, how?

Comfort, trust and a peace of mind is what every couple wishes for from their vendors. I truly was blessed to receive that from Frontier. I never felt stressed out. In fact, they would give wedding advice and tips for other aspects of planning my wedding!

Did you get anything else from Frontier other than your Wedding Dress?

It's very hard to go into Frontier and not fall
