





CALACATTA CREMO

A tonal variation on classic Calacatta marbles, this elegant slab features shifting veins of caramel, saddle tan, and deep vanilla against a ground that ranges from eggshell to crème brûlée. With significant variation within each block, Calacatta Crema can run from intensely to sparingly veined from slab to slab. Quarried in Carrara, Italy, and offered in polished 2cm slab.
