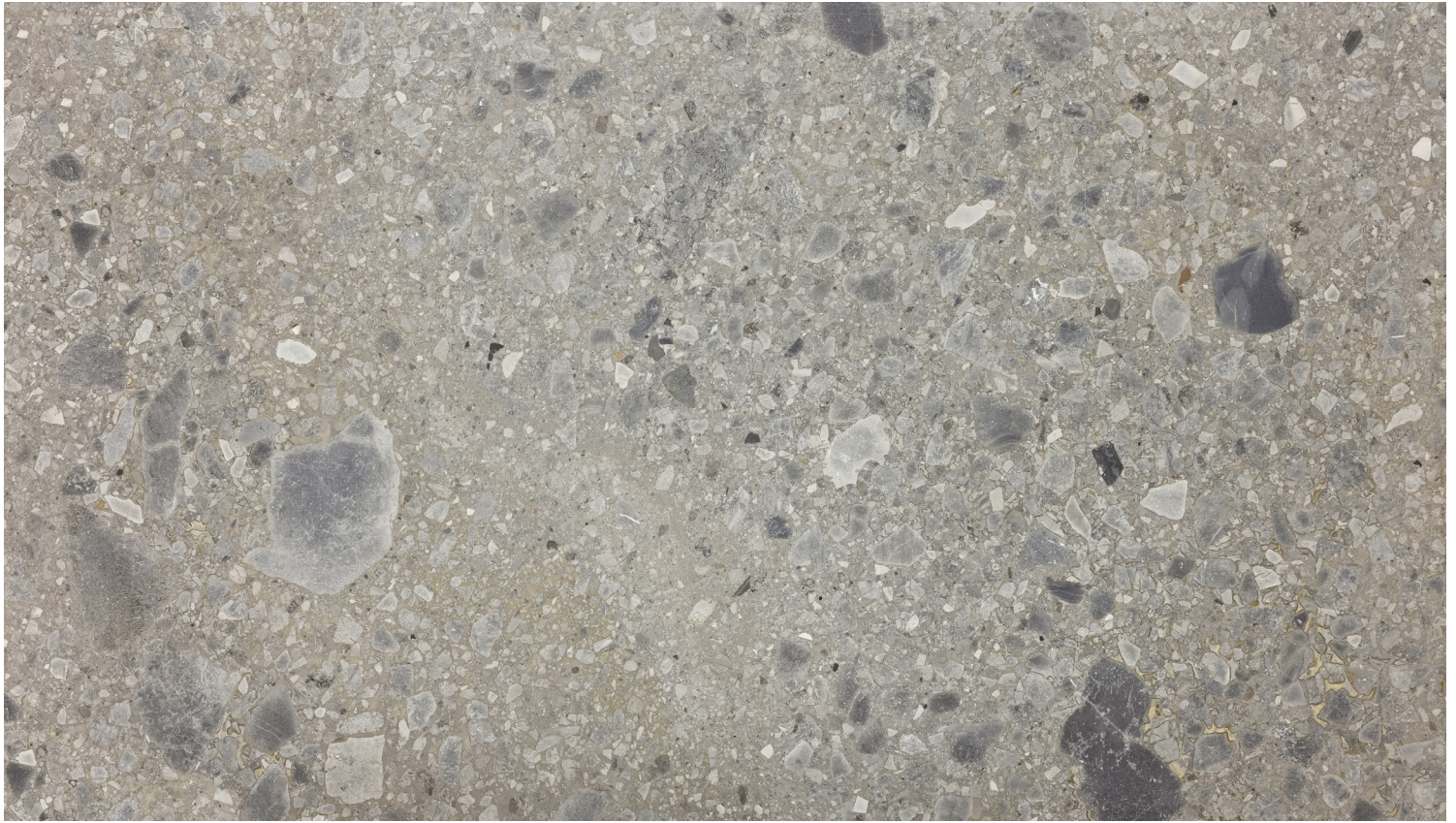






CEPPO DI GRE

Quarried in the town of Gré on the slopes of Monte Clemo near Bergamo in Italy, Ceppo di Gré is sedimentary dolomitic breccia, with large chunks and smaller pebbles of vivid blue-grey stone against paler and warmer greys. Though reminiscent of man-made agglomerate terrazzos, Ceppo di Gré occurs naturally, and is a strikingly dramatic choice for modern interiors. Stocked in honed and filled 2cm slabs.
