
## **VERDE ALPI SLAB**


A deep green brecciated serpentine with areas of black and white. Quarried in the Valle d'Aosta region of northwestern Italy, Verde Alpi is a classic serpentine - part of a unique stone group named for its resemblance to snake skin that has been sought since antiquity.
