

2025 Marvelous Mystery Quilt Introduction/Fabric Requirements



It's time for the 2025 Marvelous Mystery! The main body of the quilt will be 84" x 84". Then, it has a single 6" fabric border which makes the quilt finish at 96" x 96" (You could adjust the width of this border to make the size a little larger or smaller). The quilt is designed for beginners, but will be lots of fun for quilters of all levels. Directions will include step-by-step instructions with illustrations and video tutorials to help you make your quilt marvelous! The quilt is made with traditional piecing. There will be an option to include a little applique' (I will show techniques for both hand and machine applique' when we get to that part).

Fabric 1 Border	Select a multicolored fabric you love with lots of colors
2 yards if you cut from the width of fabric and	and interest. Start with this fabric. Use this fabric to select

3 yards if you cut from the length of the fabric

Fabric 2 Background	Light value
4½ yards	All other fabrics should contrast or stand out from the

Fabric 3	Medium value
1½ yards	A color that is in your border

Fabric 4	Medium value
1 yard	Select a color that is in your border

Fabric 5	Medium value
1 yard	Select a color that is in your border Coordinates with

Fabric 6	Medium value
½ yard	Select a color that is in your border Coordinates with
	fabric 3, 4, and 5
Fabric 7	Dark value
2 ½ yards	All other fabrics should have strong contrast from this

If you like scrappy quilts, you could use multiple fabrics for fabrics 3, 4, 5, and 6. To do this you would select at least ¼ yard pieces of fabrics that are the same color/value for each fabric. For example, my fabric 3 is orange. I could use six to eight quarter yard cuts of assorted orange fabrics that are similar in value and color. You would mix and match them as fabric 3. If you use scraps, you may need more than the 1 ½ yards depending on how you choose to use them. Cutting directions will be based on full width of fabric. If you use fat quarters, you will need to cut two strips to make the width of fabric cuts. I do not recommend making Fabrics 1, 2, or 7 scrappy.

You will also need

- 1 yard for binding
- 3 yards of wide backing (or 9 yards 42" wide fabric if you piece the backing)
- King-sized batting of your choice
