How to Install Kiravans Handbrake Lowering Kit

Suitable for: VW Transporter T5, T6, T6.1 Time for the job: 10-15 minutes Tools required:

- Electrical tape
- 13mm Socket Spanner
- Socket spanner extension piece
- Flat head screwdriver
- M5 Allen key
- 1. Before working on the handbrake: put the van in gear & chock your wheels.
- 2. Remove handbrake cover by pushing away the small tab beneath the front of the handle. Use a flat screwdriver.
- 3. Remove the OEM trim by lifting up and sliding over the handbrake.
- 4. Remove 2 x nuts using a 13mm socket. An extension piece will help with the front nut.
- 5. Lift away the handbrake. You may need to loosen off the handbrake cable tension beforehand.
- 6. Fit the supplied self-grip U-channel onto the middle ridge.
- 7. Fit the clear split tube over your brake cable. Apply 3 pieces of electrical tape to stop it coming off.
- 8. Attach the new bracket to your handbrake using supplied nuts, bolts and washers. Use a 13mm spanner with an M5 allen key.
- 9. Present the bracket to the original hand brake mounting. Ensure that the cable and clear tube are both in place.
- 10. Fix the new bracket in place using original nuts and 13mm socket.
- 11. Tighten up the brake cable such that your handbrake operates as before. If you are unsure about the correct tension then please consult an auto mechanic.
- 12. Fit the new trim plastic. It will click into place as the locators find their position.
- 13. Re-apply the original handbrake cover. The left face fits outside the edge of your new trim box.
- 14. Check that the handbrake cover clip is back in its original locating position.
