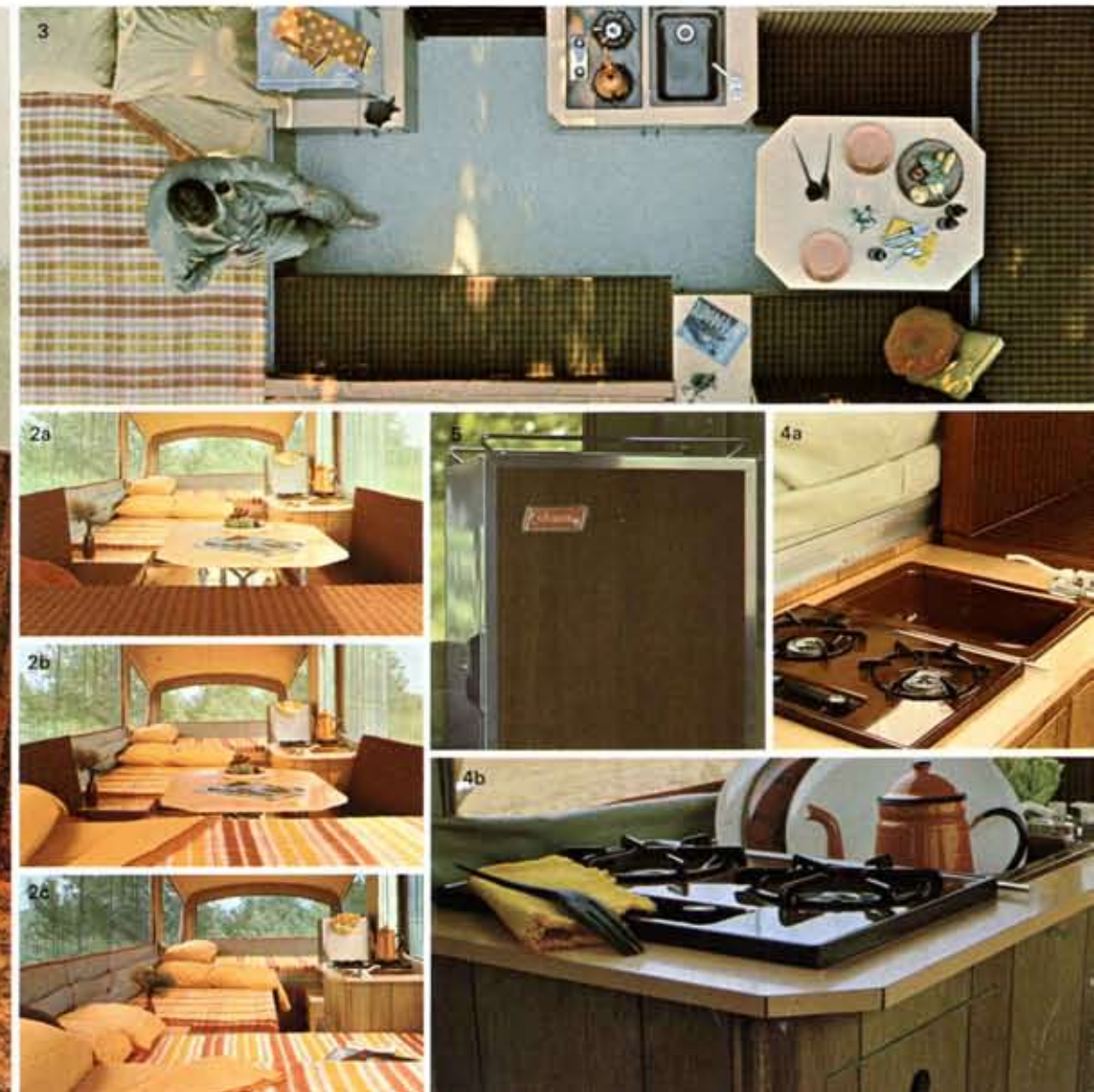

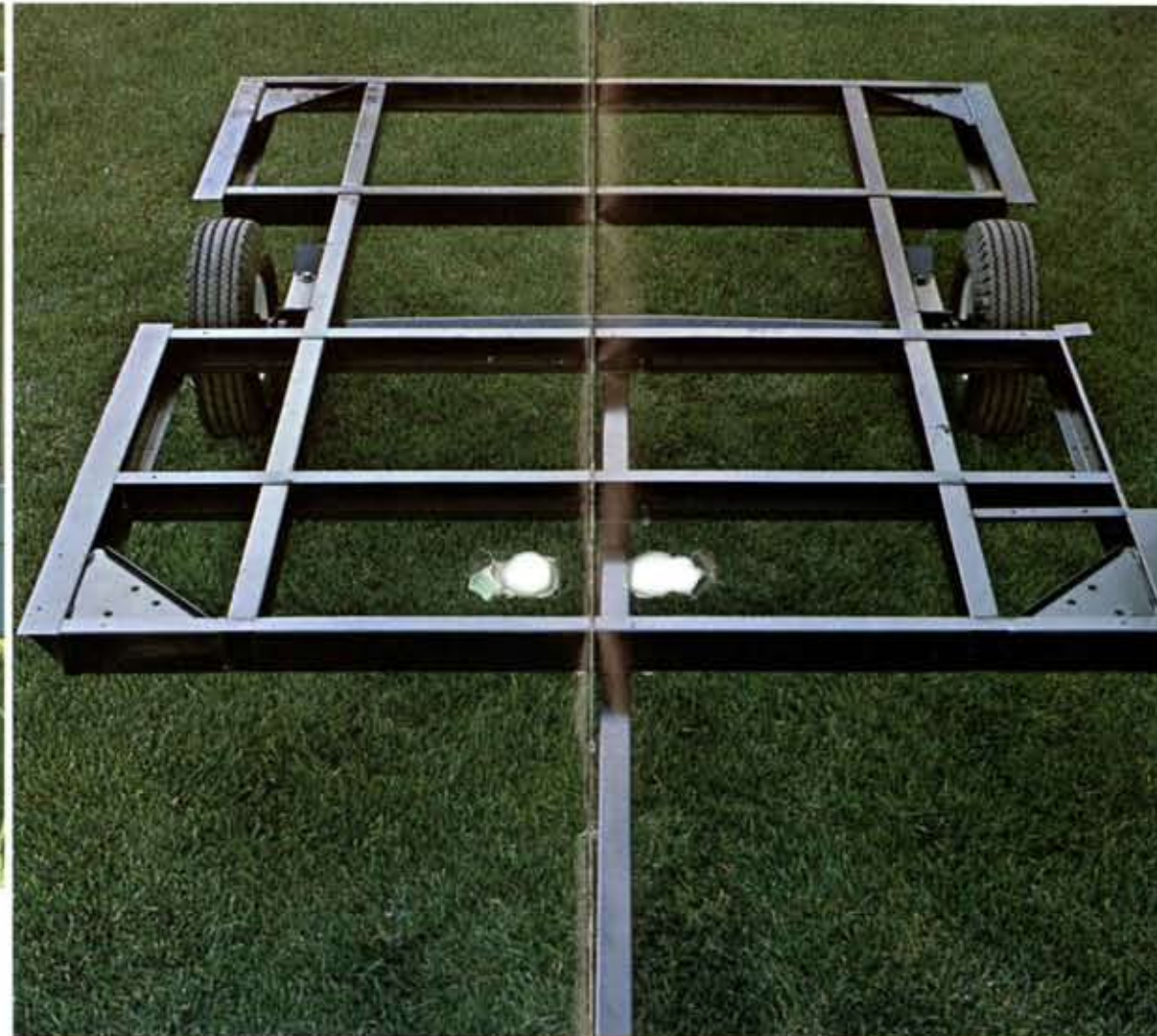


Up she goes. Full-height screen door stores in trailer roof during travel—out of the way.

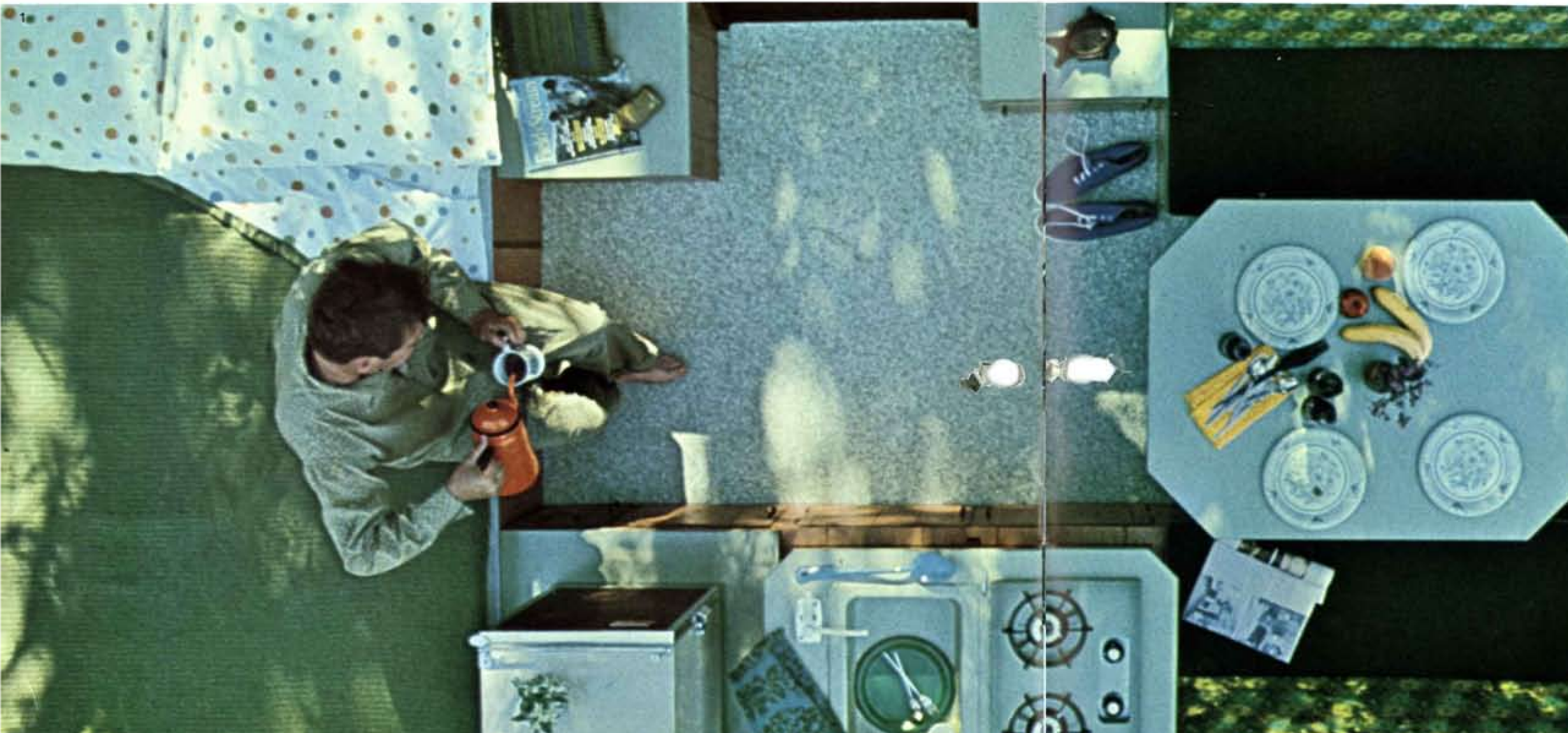


Aluminum body and hard-top. Both body and top are rugged, corrosion-resistant, top-grade aluminum. Finished to last with long-life vinyl coating.
