





Construction.

Coleman trailers feature riveted and painted heavygauge rustproof aluminum side walls and corner supports. No other manufacturer offers this type of construction. Compare with aluminum sheeting—screwed and glued to plywood siding—which is tough and expensive to



Coleman trailers have permanently attached built-in bed supports, dolly wheel (not on Colorado), step and jacks and dinette table legs. On other campers, these items are unattached and can easily be misplaced.

Component storage.





Lifters. Coleman's heavygauge stainless steel aircraft cable lift system is the strongest and most dependable in the industry. It operates smoothly and features a failsafe mechanism. Some competitive trailers utilize an external scissor-type lift arm system that often requires two people to set up and take down. And is always exposed to damage, even in down position.



Lift cable diameter.


Coleman trailers use 1/8"diameter stainless steel aircraft cable—the strongest in the industry. Compare with smaller steel cables, prone to break or rust.





Side wall cross section.


Coleman trailers utilize an automotive-type double wall construction. Compare with single wall, no buffer zone; slight damage to exterior can result in major interior damage.



Step height.


Coleman's exclusive selfstoring Stepper™ is a big, wide, sturdy step positioned low enough so that even a small child has no problem entering the trailer. Our Stepperlite™ provides ample illumination for safe entry and exit. The smaller, higher step typical of other campers makes entrance into the living area more difficult.






Wiring

For safety, Coleman's wiring is enclosed and protected. This reduces the chance of the wiring becoming frayed or severed.



Door.

Coleman trailers feature a wide, one-piece aluminum screen door with a waisthigh door knob and automatic return. Measure the difference—don't accept narrow two-piece doors and awkward, knee-level knob positioning.

Smoked-vinyl windows create a dark inside environment; Coleman's clear vinyl windows let all the light inside, especially on cloudy days, thus brightening the living space.





Coleman's locked-in-place dinette seats are woodbacked for support. Not tossed-in cushions that neither support nor stay in place.






Stove. Coleman's outdoor stove is capable of generating 10,000 BTUs per burner of heat, enough power to cook even in a breeze. Compare with the 5,500 BTUs per burner of most competitive stoves, really meant to be used indoors. They're inefficient for outdoor use; take four times longer to bring water to a boil.*
