INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the three arctic white rivets provided, rivet the hinge attached to the spare tire cover to the bumper of the trailer. The portion of the hinge riveted to the bumper will be inside the spare tire cover when closed. (See diagram)

NOTE: The pre-drilled holes in the bumper <u>must</u> be 7/8" from the edge of the bumper closest to the rear body panel. On some early production units the holes were drilled 3/8" from the edge; this is incorrect and new holes must be drilled.

- 2. Using two of the expansion rivets provided, attach the keeper bracket to the pre-drilled holes located near the top of the spare tire indentation on the rear body panel. (See diagram) Insert grommet in square cutout in keeper bracket. The grommet should be installed from the top of the keeper bracket.
- 3. Using the remaining expansion rivet and washer, attach the cable from the spare tire cover to the predrilled hole on the left-hand side of the spare tire indentation on the rear body panel. (See diagram)
- 4. Install the spare tire mount bolts (not supplied with this kit) in the holes located in the center of the spare tire indentation on the rear body panel. Place spare tire on bolts and fasten with lug nuts from spare tire mount bolt kit.
- 5. Close the spare tire cover. Place the screw provided down through the pre-drilled hole in the top of the spare tire cover and through the grommet in the keeper bracket. Tighten securely.
