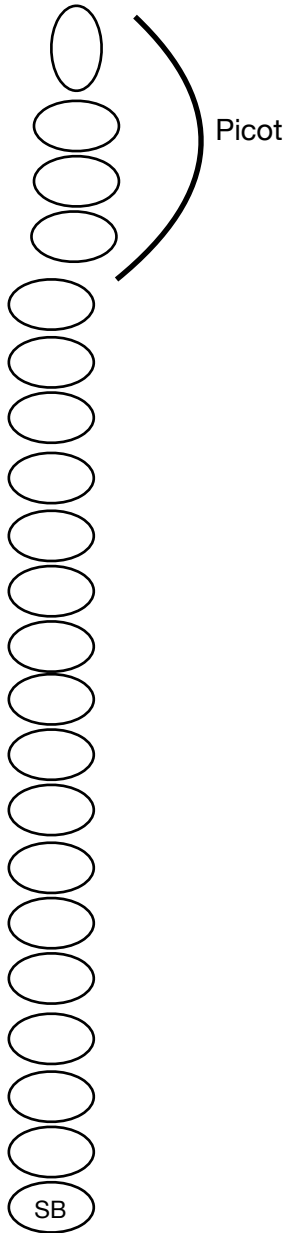
For every colorway there are multiple combinations. Each will yield a slightly different width of netting. The easiest way to adjust the width is to adjust the number of beads in the picots: a minimum of 3 and maximum of ??? (there is no max!)

For the 20mm bead, begin with a stop bead (this will stay in the work and be part of the pattern) and 17 beads, including the stop bead. Add beads for the picots as desired.

wood bead.

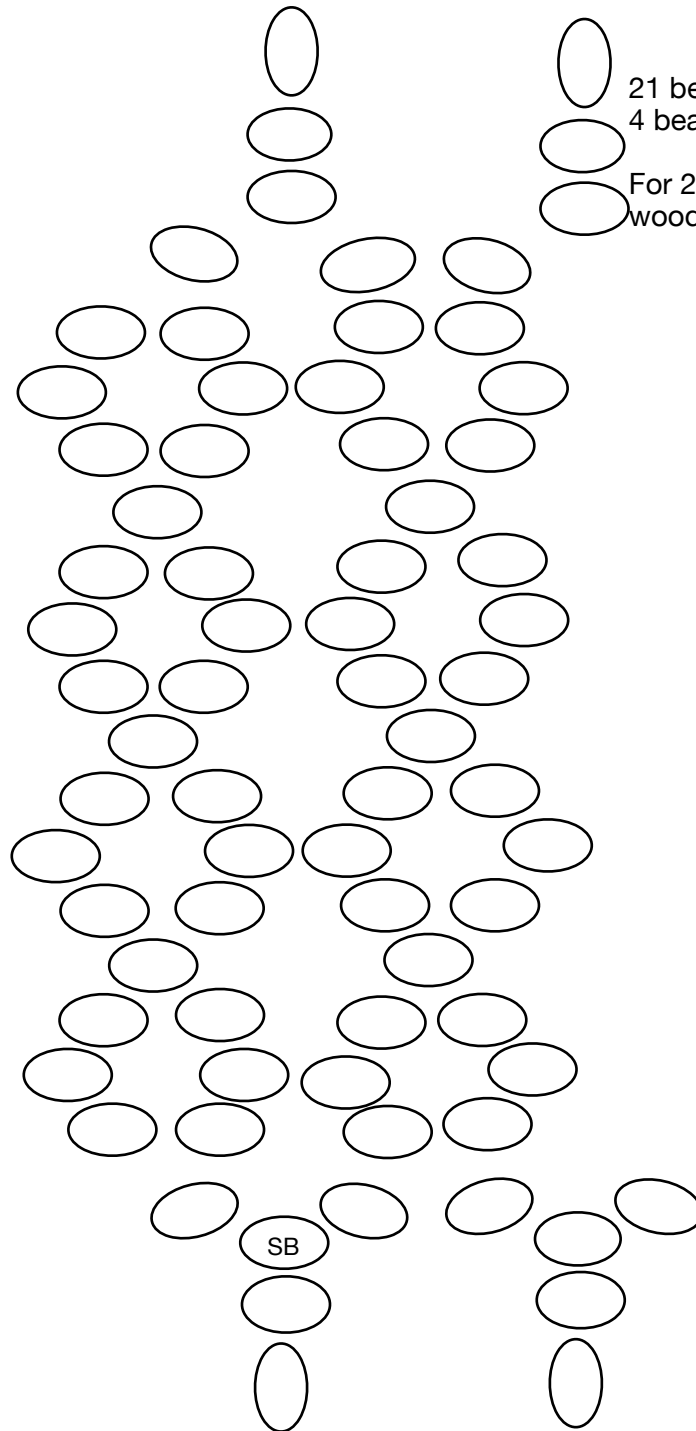

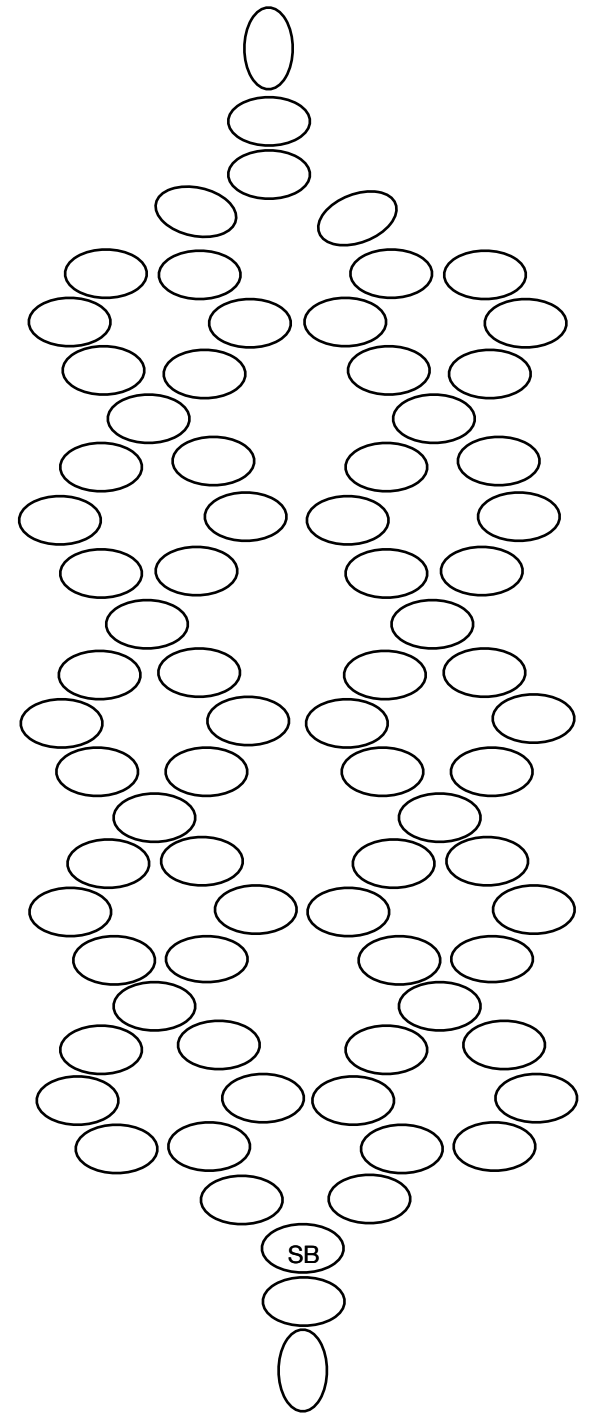
21 beads plus
