

Picard Bead Museum

Emily and Kate mention videos taken at The Picard Bead Museum at the end of the bead retreat. We've posted them on <u>Facebook</u>, if you'd like to view them. And, be sure to <u>watch Grace</u> at the Istanbul Market in Turkey...it's just all amazing!



In Forged Earrings, it's all about wire. Kate talks about wire gauges and how hammering and forming helps harden the wire. To make components like spirals and curly q's, use 16 and 18 gauge wire.



Watch how they create a spiral. Emily does hers a bit differently than Kate.



Hammering is more gentle than most might think. Keep your hammer rather loose and relaxed in your hand and it's more tapping than like hammering a nail into the wall.



Emily works with 18 gauge Antique Bronze wire and Czech Glass Rondelles on head pins.



These techniques will net you components for earrings, clasps, and even chain.



The ladies show you how to easily make your own jump rings.



And for clasps, they demo a Figure 8.



The possibilities are really endless! You can also make your own ear wires out of 18 or 20 gauge wire. This is such a great broadcast. If you've ever been thinking of getting a bench block and hammer, now is a great time...the results are really nice, they make great gifts, and it's very affordable.
