- 1. find the right size griffin that works with 90% of your beads. if you are knotting work with natural stones, a few might not work.
- 2. put a tape flag 2" up from tail of griffin.

4. Begin Knotting between each bead. It's a good idea to lay out your pattern so you don't mess up your lead count.

5. Some of my oval beads had large holes. As an advanced wader, I can do a double knot. However, if you're a new that ter, knother, it's okay to do 2 Kaots. Just carefully do the second knot so it lands above the first Knot.

6. Continue Knotting until you get to your center. Add a Knot after your last bead. If your want to add an embellishment to your disc, you have 2 options glue it now give at lat give of later macramé has - 40 go through openings. macrane first and Then give on button use Zap glue for this. or subellishment: you might have but of button Shank. 8. I secured Sha mine to a design thay for a 30mm disc, I had to square knot about 62-64mm. macrainé back towards the disc about 2 full square Knots. and a lect of 65 hypo to secure Threads. burn excess thread off. 9. add your tessel before your with thread Burner macrane.
