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Nature's Hope

Ingredients:

8-2033 Matte Opaque Lt. Olive Luster 8-4243 Duracoat S/L Dyed Topaz Gold 8-4204F Duracoat Galvanized Matte Champagne 8-4222- Duracoat Galvanized Pewter 8-132FR- Matte Transparent Light Topaz AB Parasol Cap - Antique Brass O Beads - Metallic Mix Fireline-4lb Smoke Grey Hana Thread - Pebble Zap Glue Size 10 Beading Needles

Optional Ingredients:

Embellishment

Maple Leaves (5) - Golden Umber 9mm Oval Coil Jump Ring (1)- Antique Copper 6mm Round Coil Jump Ring (1) - Antique Copper Antique Copper Jump Rings (2) - 5.4mm/16g 1.5 inch Head Pins (5) - Antique Copper Circle Back Chain- Antique Copper


Troika - Antique Brass Green Garnet (6) - 6mm Round ParaWire Vintage Bronze - 24G Swivel Clasp - Antique Brass 6mm Soldered Jump Ring (1) Antique Brass 4mm Oval Jump Rings - Antique Brass

Peyote Stitch Seed Bead School




Please Note: This handout assumes a basic knowledge of Peyote Stitch and Seed Bead Weaving. See Additional Learning for more instruction.




Cut about a yard (or a comfortable length) of Fireline. Add a stopper bead and string on 20 beads. This will be Rows 1 and 2.



Begin stitching Row 3 and continue all the way across.



3 Rows completed.




Continue in peyote stitch until 12 rows are completed. Remove stopper bead.




Reinforce the center of the tube: Thread a needle with the tail and weave the end into the center (approx. 3 columns in). String on enough beads to cover the center of the tube minus the length of both Parasol Caps.




Use the Parasol Caps to measure the distance. Be sure there is enough room for the Caps and the beads. Secure the tail by weaving into the piece. Trim the end of thread.



Using the existing thread (or adding thread if necessary), zip up the tube by weaving back and forth on each edge. Reinfore by weaving back and forth. Trim thread.




Thread your needle with about a yard of Hana thread. Secure the thread in the tube by weaving back and forth. Exit on one side of the tube. You will now start the body of the pendant. String on a bead.




Continue working in peyote stitch and follow the pattern for the body of the pendant.




Insert the Parasol Caps into the ends of the tube making sure they fit securely. Do not glue at this time. Remove to continue.




Following the pattern, "skip the 1st bead and go through the next bead."



Close-up of the body of the pendant atached to the tube section.



The pattern complete. You are now ready to add the O Beads.



Add thread if you are running short. Make sure the thread is exiting on Row 31.



Keeping to peyote stitch, begin adding the O Beads. Note: I add only 1 bead on the ends as I have found it gets too bulky if I add 2 beads. If you like the O beads to flare out, then add 2 beads in all spaces.





Add O Beads until you reach the desired length. Weave your tail back into the piece and secure.



Glue in the Parasol Caps on each end of the tube using Zap glue. Only do one cap at a time as the glue dries quickly. Align the cap loops so that they are parallel to the sides of the body. This ensures your pendant will hang properly. Let the caps dry for 24 hours. You can then embellish your pendant and add a chain of your choice.







Monthly Mix - Sakura Skies O Beads - Crystal Sliperit 11/0 Duracoat Galvanized Pewter Parasol Caps - Antique Copper Button - Apple Blossom, Gold 2/0 Matubo - Crystal Bronze Luster 0.4mm CKC - Treebark 0.5mm CKC - Treebark Fireline - 4lb Crystal Zap Glue Size 10 Beading Needles

Matte Angelite - 4mm Round


