


GENERAL INFO:

- This wallpaper is sold in 10m rolls.
- No claims for faulty wallpaper can be made once the wallpaper has been cut for application to walls; please check your order as soon as it arrives to avoid disappointment.
- This wallpaper is block printed in the UK using traditional methods and so variation can occur between batches. Because of this, we advise that you add 1-2 rolls onto your order to allow for future repairs.
- · Florentine Flowers wallpaper is treated with a matt varnish glaze which means it's suitable for high traffic areas. It can be gently wiped, but not washed.
- Unfortunately we cannot accept returns of unused rolls.
- All intellectual property rights in designs are owned by Beata Heuman Limited.

HANGING ADVICE AND INSTRUCTIONS

- We advise to use a wallpaper installer who is experienced in hanging high quality hand printed papers.
- Always check quantities with your installer prior to purchase and installation.
- Always confirm with your installer which way up the paper is to be hung, prior to installation.
- Walls should always be prepared, smooth, sealed and we recommend that the walls are cross lined prior to installation with a suitable paper, a good wallpaper installer should be able to recommend which paper is needed.
- For installation, we recommend a pre-mixed Beeline Black pase, or if self mixing is preferred Solvite paste.
- Florentine Flowers is made up of various motifs that appear to be identical, but on closer inspection, they differ slightly down the 56cm repeat.
- Ensure that the hanger takes the pattern repeat into account before cutting adjacent lengths. The hanger should measure and cut the wallpaper to wall height allowing for wastage at the top and bottom.
- To install the paper, apply paste evenly to the paper, paying particular attention to paste right to the edges. It is recommended to apply the paste to the paper vertically rather than horizontally.
- Once the paste is applied, 10-15 minutes is usually enough time for the paper to properly relax and become supple enough to hang, but this can vary, so it is recommended to perform a soak test to see how much soaking time is needed.
- Do not over soak, this can cause the water content in the paste to deteriorate the paper fibre under even the slightest pressure; for this reason, do not paste more than one cut length at a time.
- Match the pattern at eye level, and use a spirit level and faint pencil line to ensure the paper is vertical.
- Place the paper onto the wall. Joins should be tightly butted and never overlap.
- Do not allow paste to contaminate the printed surface as this may cause
 the pattern to lift when wiped whilst wet. However, if this does happen,
 remove it immediately by gently and carefully wiping with a clean, damp
 sponge with cold water only.
- Whilst ensuring the wallpaper is firmly stuck down, avoid rolling the seams
 too soon as this will squeeze paste out of the seam area, cause contamination
 with the printed surface and may cause seam shrinkage. Overworking the
 seams can burnish the matt appearance of the printed surface and so should
 be avoided. A felt steamroller is recommended, not a sponge.
- Cut off any excess at the top and bottom.
- For subsequent drops, ensure the pieces are cut at the exact same point in the design as your previous drop in order for the pattern to match horizontally.
