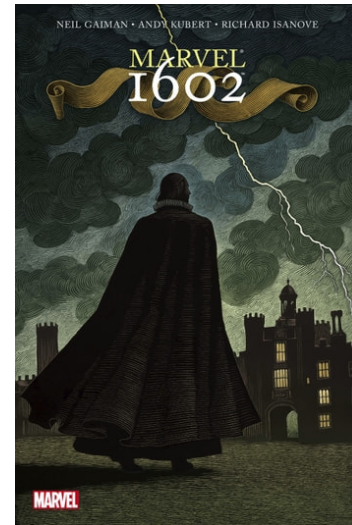

## WB-Discovery Drama Week 2

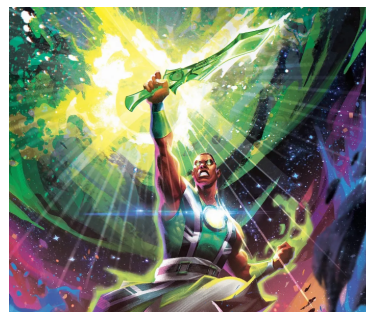


The crazy shakeup from Warner Bros. merger with Discovery has continued to rock the industry! Here's the highlights from this week:

DC has confirmed today that the Emerald Knight will be returning in his own one-shot this November. Written by Geoffrey Thorne and art by Marco Santucci, the book will see John Stewart square off against a god gone mad!



## Frank Miller Sues For Ownership of DKR Art

Today it was revealed that comic book legend Frank Miller is suing Jennifer Bush-Kraft, widow of former DC editor David Anthony Kraft and his estate, over cover art used on the Comics Interview Magazine in 1983 and 1986 to promote The Dark Knight Returns and Ronin. The lawsuit claims the following:

*"In each instance, Miller and Kraft agreed – consistent with the custom and usage in the trade at the time – that (a) Kraft could retain the Works for a period of time, (b) each of the Works could not be used for any purpose other than as cover art for the respective issues of Comics Interview referred to above and (c) both of the Works would remain Miller's property and would be returned to him after the use as cover art was completed and, in all events, upon demand" and stated "The DKR Work is of particular value because it is one of the earliest (although not the first) work of cover art depicting (a) Batman in the distinctive "Dark Knight Returns" style and (b) Carrie Kelley." Also that "Beginning in the 1980s and at times thereafter, Miller, directly or indirectly, and Miller's publisher asked Kraft to return the Works and other pieces of art that Miller had loaned to him for use as covers for issues of Comics Interview. Kraft returned one such artwork — a piece created by Miller and delivered to Kraft for use as cover art for an issue of Comics Interview featuring an interview with Miller about his Sin City comic series, which is not at issue here. Kraft did not, however, return either of the Works, leading Miller and his publisher (which reported the*

results of its requests to Miller) to believe that they had been lost."

Miller learned of the pieces after discovering that Bush-Kraft was planning to auction them off. The auction house is currently holding onto the pieces as they await a verdict.

Jennifer Bush-Kraft has claimed that her late husband kept meticulous notes and that she believes the artwork was given by Miller as a gift.

## Valiant Comics Still Active

Last week it was reported that Valiant had laid off some of its staff. This week Valiant's PR released a statement saying that Valiant is coming back strong and the new Bloodshot series will debut in September as planned.
