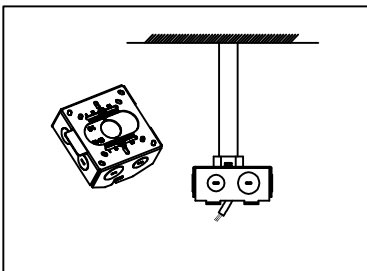
- To prevent personal injury or product damage only licensed electricians should install.

## 1. Unpacking

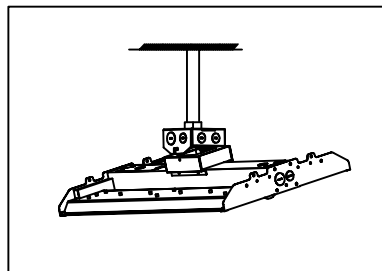
Thoroughly inspect the fixture for freight damage. Freight damage should be reported to the delivery carrier.

## 2. Installation

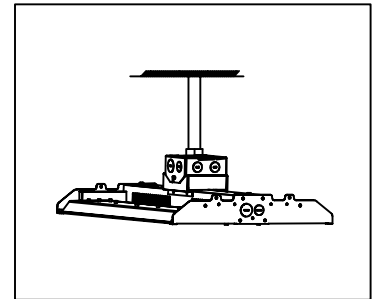
1) .Adjust the hole on the connection plate to the center of the top cover and fix the screws on both sides. Then fix the connection plate to the pendant. Please make sure the screw nut is fixed tightly to the pendant.



2) .Hang the fixture to the hook of the top cover, and connect AC line

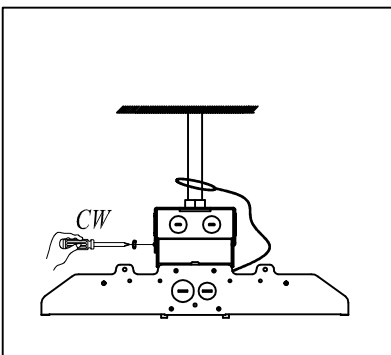


2) .Move the fixture to make the profile hole in the top cover match with the side screws in the bottom cover of the junction box. Remember to move the fixture to the right place

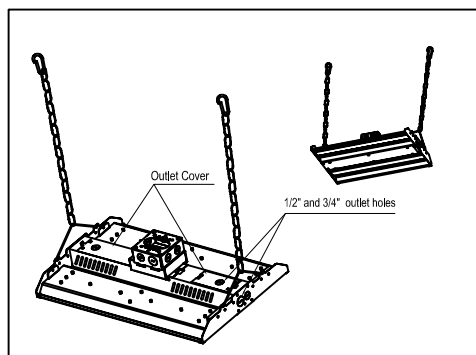


## 3.Chain Installation

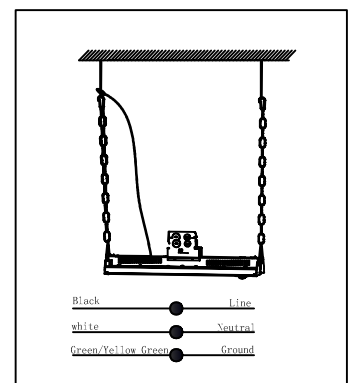
4) .Twist the side screws tightly in a clockwise. Fasten the lock rope.



1) .Open packing box, then take the chain through both side hook and adjust suitable length.



2) .when the chain length adjusted ok, Put fixture fixed on Hooks. Fasten the lock rope.
