$1 / 2$ yard Tossed Houses - Red (H) 2482-88
$3 / 8$ yard Dots - White/Red (I) 2485-18

7/8 yard Lemoyne Star - Red (K) 2479-88
$23 / 4$ yards Lemoyne Star - Red (Backing) 2479-88

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Holly Hill Christmas Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (6) $3 / 4 / 4 \times 51 / 2$ " strips each centered on a word.

From the Candy Cane Stripe - Green (B), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $11 / 2 " \times 33 / 4 "$ strips.


## From the Dots - White/Green (C), cut:

-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Bias Plaid - Red (D), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $11 / 2 " \times 33 / 4 "$ strips.

From the Holly Swirls - Green (E), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (F), cut: - (3) $53 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $53 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.

## From the Circles - Green (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (11) Star templates.


## From the Tossed Houses - Red (H), cut:

- (4) $21 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) $21 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 4 "$ squares.

From the Dots - White/Red (I), cut:

- (2) $21 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) $21 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) $21 / 4 "$ squares.

From the Circles - White (J), cut:
-(2) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 371 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Lemoyne Star - Red (K), fussy cut:

- (2) $51 / 4 " \times 391 / 4 "$ WOF strips each centered on (2) rows of stars.
- (2) $51 / 4 " \times 40$ " WOF strips each centered on (2) rows of stars.

From the Lemoyne Star - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 48 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48 " x 57 " back.


## Block Assembly

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press (1) Fabric G star onto (1) $71 / 2 " \times 53 / 4$ " Fabric F strip.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One rectangle.
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (11) Block One rectangles.

6. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 33 / 4 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 " \times 33 / 4 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (3) Block Two rectangles total.

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7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Three rectangles.

8. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) $21 / 4 "$ Fabric I square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of (1) $21 / 4$ " Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $71 / 2 " \times 53 / 4$ " Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (11) Block Four rectangles total.

9. Follow Figure 5 and sew together the assorted (28) blocks into a $4 \times 7$ matrix to make the Center Block. The block should measure $281 / 2 " \times 371 / 4 "$.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 371 / 4 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $5^{1 / 4 " \times 391 / 4 " \text { Fabric } K \text { strip to each side of the }}$ Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 4 " \times 40$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
