

- 1. Remove the rear bumper. Two fixing behind the side trim panels (Saloon only) five clips around each wheel arch, and clips along the bottom edge.
- 2. Temporarily disconnect reversing sensors.
- 3. Remove bumper inner beam/arms. (These are not refitted.)
- 4. Cut a section from the lower trim 80mm wide x 100mm deep.
- 5. Using Item E with Item G bolt Item A to the existing captive nuts on the rear panel.
- 6. Fully tighten all bolts and ensure the towbar is rigid and secure.
- 7. Refit bumper and reversing sensors.
- 8. Using Item **D** with Item **F** bolt Item **B** to Item **A**.
- 9. Using Item **C** bolt the ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to the mounting plate.



Note:

1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)

2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
