

Tow-Trust Towbars



- 1. Locate and remove the tape on the outer face of each chassis member, this will reveal the towbar mounting points.
- 2. Remove the two fixings securing the lower edge of the bumper.
- **3.** Remove the two fixings securing the rearmost exhaust rubber mounting. Pull exhaust mounting off the two studs.
- 4. Carefully manoeuvre the towbar over the exhaust
- 5. Using item **D** with item **G** bolt Item A to the existing threaded holes in the outer face of each chassis member.
- 6. Using item E with item F bolt Item B to Item A.
- 7. Using item C bolt the ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to the mounting plate.
- 8. Fully tighten all nuts and bolts and ensure the towbar is rigid and secure.
- 9. Refit exhaust mounting.
- **10.** Refit lower edge of bumper.



Note:

1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)

2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers' trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
