

Tow-Trust Towbars



- **1.** Locate and remove the three existing bolts from the left hand chassis member
- 2. Remove fixings from lower edge of bumper. Note: on 5 door models, temporarily remove mud flaps (if fitted) and metal plates to gain easy access for bolts K and J.
- **3.** Using Item **K** with Item **L**, loosely bolt Item **E** to the existing threaded hole on the inside face of each chassis member.
- 4. Using Item K with Item L, loosely bolt Item B and Item C to the existing threaded holes in the outer face of each chassis member. Note: on 5 door models, bolt Item D at the same time as Item B and Item C, and bolt to existing forward threaded hole using Item K with Item L.
- 5. Locate Item A between each chassis, and using Item J, bolt to Item E, and to Item B, and Item C.
- 6. Using Item H with Item L, bolt Item F and Item M to Item A
- 7. Using Item G, bolt the ball bracket (not supplied in this kit) to the mounting plate.
- 8. Fully tighten all nuts and bolts and ensure the towbar is rigid and secure.
- 9. Refit metal plates, mud flaps (where removed) and lower edge of bumper



Note: Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
