

BUMPER REMOVAL:

- 1. First remove two fixings from each rear light cluster and pull rearward to release, this will reveal one bumper fixing under each light, locate and remove.
- 2. Remove six fixings along the top edge and six fixings along the lower edge.
- **3.** Remove three fixings around each wheel arch.

TOWBAR INSTALLATION:

- 1. Lower the spare wheel to gain access to all Towbar mounting points.
- 2. Remove the rear crash beam from the rear panel and towing eye nearside chassis member. (Crash beam and towing eye are not refitted with Towbar assembly)
- 3. Using Item E with Item J loosely bolt Items B to the inside face of each correct chassis member.
- 4. Using Item F with Item J loosely bolt Items B to the vertical mounting point in each chassis member.
- 5. Using Item F with Item K bolt Item A between each side arm.
- 6. Using Item D with Item K and item H with Item K bolt Item C and Item M to Item A.
- 7. Fully tighten all nuts and bolts ensuring Towbar is rigid square and secure.
- Cut bumper as shown in sketch (2007 2013 ONLY) and refit using Item G and Item L on the bumper tabs (Use Item M on 2013> Vehicles ONLY>).



Note:

Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
