

Tow-Trust Towbars

Fitting Instruction



BUMPER REMOVAL:

- 1. Remove the rear light clusters, open tailgate & remove the plastic inner cover from each light cluster to reveal one fixing per cluster. (Pull rearwards so clips don't break).
- 2. Remove wheel arch trim to reveal one tip fixing, remove two fixings from the wheel arch liner.
- 3. Remove six fixings from the bumper lower edge. (Some models may have eight fixings).
- 4. Carefully pull bumper out sideways to release from vehicle body then rearward to remove, unplug fog light and reversing sensors.
- **5.** Remove the rear impact (This is not refitted with the Towbar assembly).
- 6. Remove plastic brackets covering rearmost mounting points from either side of the vehicle, one screw and four clips per bracket.

TOWBAR INSTALLATION:

- 1. Insert Item **B1** into the N/S chassis and Item **B2** into the O/S chassis and fix in place at the forward mounting point only using Items **E** and Items **H**.
- 2. Insert Item A between each side arm and into the open ends of the chassis and fix through the rearmost mounting point on the vehicle using Item E and Items H.
- 3. Using Item E with Item J fix the side arms to Item A.
- 4. Fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 5. Refit the plastic brackets, rear bumper and light clusters.
- 6. Fix Item C and Item D to Item A using Items F with Items J and Item G.
- 7. Fully tighten all remaining fixings.



Notes:

- For Torque settings see general notes overleaf.
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
