BUMPER REMOVAL:

- 1. Open tailgate and remove rear light clusters, two fixings per light cluster.
- 2. Lower spare wheel.
- 3. Remove rear bumper, two fixings found in each light cluster area, five fixings around each wheel arch, three fixings on the bumper lower edge by wheel arch each side.
- 4. Remove four fixings through rear panel securing the impact beam to the vehicle.
- Carefully pull bumper tips out sideways releasing the bumper from the vehicle body, Disconnect the wiring loom on the N/S and remove the rear bumper.
 - Note: The centre of the bumper is firmly attached to the vehicle but has no fixings.
- 6. Remove the rear impact beam from inside the rear bumper (this will get refitted directly to Item A), remove the metal mounting brackets from the rear impact beam and discard.
- 7. Remove the central bumper tag from the rear impact beam and discard (FIG: 2)
- **8.** Cut the central bumper tag from the bumper FIG: 1.
- 9. Lower and support the AdBlue tank.
- **10.** Lower and support the exhaust silencer.

Note: The rearmost rubber must be removed from the silencer and not the vehicle.

TOWBAR INSTALLATION:

- Using Item H with Item Q fit Item C to Items B1 and B2 and fully tighten. (creating side arm assemblies) Note: ensure the orientation of Item C is correct. (FIG: 4)
- 2. Loosely fit Item G with Item P a couple of turns into each chassis vertical mounting point.
- 3. Using Item G with Item Q fit side arm assemblies to each chassis.
- 4. Fit Item A to the rear panel using Item J and Item R on the outer mounting points (M10) and Item H with Item Q on the inner points (M12), using Item D as a clamp plate on Item A. (FIG: 3)
- 5. Using Item K with Item Q fix item A to side arm assemblies.
- 6. Fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 7. Raise the AdBlue tank and exhaust silencer onto its hangers.
- 8. Using Item L with Item S refit the impact beam to Item A.
- 9. Refit the rear bumper and light clusters. When refitting the rear bumper ensure wiring loom is clipped into position.
- 10. Using Item M with Item Q and Item N with Item Q fix Item E to Item A ensuring Item T1 is fitted between the lower mounting point.
- 11. Using Item F fix your desired ball bracket and wiring plate (Not supplied in this kit) to Item E.
- 12. Fully tighten all remaining fixings.
- **13.** Raise the spare wheel.

Notes:

2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
