

BUMPER REMOVAL:

- 1. All models: Remove the boot interior trim.
- 2. All models: Remove the rear light clusters. Remove the rear bumper, two fixings found in each wheel arch, one tip fixing either side. A Class / B Class: three fixings along lower edge. CLA: five fixings along lower edge, peel back carpet to reveal 2 more fixings. All models: Two fixings through the rear panel found inside the vehicle.
- 3. Carefully release bumper tips from the vehicle then pull bumper rearwards.
- 4. Unclip any necessary wiring looms.
- 5. CLA only: Remove undertray to ease Towbar fitment.
- 6. All models: Remove the rear impact beam from the rear panel. (Impact beam is not refitted with the Towbar assembly)

TOWBAR INSTALLATION:

- 1. Using Item E with Item J fix Item A to the rear panel. (Always ensure the original gaskets are between Item A and the rear panel, we also advise an adequate sealant to be added around the Towbar and rear panel joints to stop water ingress).
- 2. Insert Items B through the Towbar end plates and secure to the outside face of each chassis member with Items F and Items K.
- 3. Using Items F and Item K fix Items B to Item A.
- 4. Using Item G with Item L and Item H with Item L fix Item C and Item D to Item A.
- **5.** Fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- **6.** Refit the rear bumper, light clusters and boot interior trim. CLA only: Refit undertray.



Note:

- 1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
