

- 1. Remove the plastic underguard. (4 screws and 5 nuts)
- 2. Remove rear bumper four plastic clips along the lower edge and two fixings in tailgate opening. Remove the two push in clips each side to release the wheel arch liner; this will reveal two fixings at each tip.
- 3. Temporarily disconnect the fog lamp wire.
- 4. Cut a slot in the lower edge of the bumper centrally 140mm wide x 50mm deep. If required trim to suit.
- 5. Temporarily remove the rearmost exhaust rubber from its hanger.
- 6. Remove the chassis caps, these are no longer required.
- 7. Locate Item **B** and Item **C** into the ends of each chassis and using Item **G** with Item **J** loosely bolt each side arm into place through the existing holes.
- 8. Using Item **H** with Item **K** bolt the side arm tags to the existing captive nuts on the rear face of the panel.
- 9. Using Item F with Item L bolt Item A to Item B and Item C.
- 10. Fully tighten all nuts and bolts and ensure the towbar is rigid and secure.
- 11. Refit the bumper, underguard and exhaust rubbers.
- 12. Using Item E bolt Item D to Item A.
- 13. Using Item **E** bolt the ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to the mounting plate.



Note: nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers' trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
