

- 1. Remove the two fixings on the lower edge of the bumper to release the bumper tags and fold down out of the way.
- **2.** Remove the four fixings holding the lower corner guards from the lower edge of the bumper and remove guards.
- 3. Remove the two lower fixings from each side of the impact beam on the back panel and discard.
- **4.** Using item **F** with item **K** loosely bolt item **A** to the two lower fixing points of the impact beam on the rear panel.
- 5. Using item **G** with item **K** bolt the side arms to the existing stud on the outside face of each chassis member.
- **6.** Using item **H** with item **L** bolt the side arms to item **A**.
- 7. Using item H with item L and item J with item L bolt item B to item A.
- 8. Using item E bolt the ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to item B.
- **9.** Fully tighten all nuts and bolts ensuring towbar is rigid and secure.
- 10. Refit corner guards and bumper tag fixings.



## Note:

- 1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
