

- Punch out the pieces with the number 1. Three of them total.
- Insert the tabs 1 into their respective holes 1, making sure the word "Front" spelled on all three pieces face the same direction, and the phrases "This side up," and "This side out" face up and out respectively.
- Punch out the pieces number 2,3, pop out the two acrylic windows 4 and 5, and pieces number 6 and 7.
- Insert the piece with hole 2 into tab 2, leaving the french lattice design facing out.
- Insert piece with hole 3 into tab 3.
- Put acrylic windows 4 and 5 in the slots behind piece 3, creating the windows for the cookie jar and tea bags stack.
- Insert piece with hole 6 into tab 6, leaving the french lattice design facing out and aligning with the acrylic windows 4 and 5.
- Insert piece with hole 7 into tab 7, leaving the french lattice design facing out.
- Insert piece with hole 8, which is the front of the tea box, into tab 8.
- Insert piece with holes 9 into tabs 9.
- Insert piece with holes 10 into tabs 10.
- Insert piece with holes 11 into tabs 11.
- Punch out ribbon piece 12 and insert in tab 12 on the front of tea box, snapping onto the tabs on the sides.



- •Punch out ribbon piece 13, place and snap on top of the number 13, right side of tea box.
- •Punch out ribbon piece 14, place and snap on top of the number 14, left side of tea box.
- Punch out ribbon piece 15, place and snap on top of the number 15, back side of tea box.
- •Set tea box aside. To assemble base/table, punch out pieces 16, four of them total, pieces 17, four total, and square pieces 18.
- •Insert legs, tabs 16, into holes 16 from the bottom up, making sure all numbers face up.
- •Insert table skirt pieces 17 into holes 17 from the bottom up.
- •Place square piece 18 on top of the slightly bigger square piece 18, making sure the holes number 19 match and face up.
- Line up tabs 19 at the bottom of the tea box with holes 19 on the base/table and press together. I find this easier when pressing with the palms of my hands.
- To assemble the lid, punch out pieces 20-27.
- Take piece with the numbers 20-23 engraved on and insert squares 20, 21, 22, and 23 in numeric order.
- Take piece with the numbers 24-27 engraved on and insert through holes 24-27, creating the lid of the tea box.
- Punch out piece 28, with the kettle and tea cup engraved on and place in the center of the ribbon of tea box.
