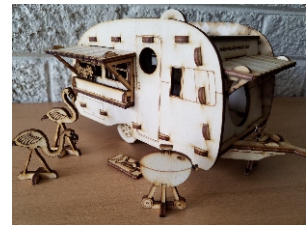


# VINTAGE CAMPER BIRD HOUSE



ONE MAN, ONE GARAGE  
BUILD. PLAY. LOVE.

Painting or staining the kit would be easier in pieces before you begin assembly.

- 1) Attach the L & R wheels to the bottom side of the base. Then, carefully snap in the jack stand in the front.
- 2) Attach the L & R Curtains to the roof, then add the loop through the center if you prefer to hang the camper.
- 3) Snap the large Side panel (with front door) to the base. Continue attaching the top and then the front and back pieces next.
- 4) Snap on the other large Side panel to complete the box.
- 5) Add the Window box Bases to each side, then sit the front of each box in place. Next, add the awning support brackets.
- 6) Add the awnings. Both sides are matching, while the front is labeled (being larger).
