



TACKLEY CHURCH

DEKORGRIP RESIN BOUND

THE NEED:

An old church, based in the rural Oxfordshire area of Tackley was in urgent need of a new pathway leading to the church doors. Its current design had an uneven gravel path leading to the main door, which a lot of the elderly in the congregation were finding mor challenging to traverse, particularly as the path was uphill all the way from the car park.

Due to the age of the church, any surface that was specified needed to look aesthetically pleasing and match the style of the surrounding environments.

SOLUTION:

The church specified a hard wearing surface with a choice of available colours that would contrast with the rustic concrete path edgings and gravestones, as well as blending in with other surroundings within the graveyard.

DekorGrip Resin Bound system in a Natural Wicker blend was the ideal choice and suited the specification perfectly. The resin bound surface having a smooth but good slip-resistance finish was ideal for elderly users as it eliminated any trip hazards along the pathway.

SUMMARY:

The installation of the surface was a great success. The look of the Natural Wicker excellently harmonised with the new path lighting housed within stone and was laid around flexible brass lettering outside the front door. it was also fully permeable which meant there was no standing water.
