

WOOLLEY HALL DEKORGRIP RESIN BOUND

THE NEED:

Steeped in history and imbued with character, Woolley Hall by Millgate offers luxury homes in a secluded, idyllic location. Built in 1780, Woolley Hall represented the height of fashionable Georgian living. Today Millgate recreates that splendour. With several classically styled detached villas, linked semi-detached mews houses, period stable conversions and grand restored mansion apartments there was a requirement for an exquisite surface to link these developments together. Although most were severed by existing asphalt surfaces, these were not in keeping with the style and elegance of the existing and new developments.

SOLUTION:

DekorGrip resin bound surfacing was installed as it both complimented and accentuated the architecture of the stately home and was idea as an overlay over the existing asphalt surface a cosmetic uplift was required. Cornfield was selected due to its natural look and thanks to the hard wearing nature of the bound surface it was ideally chosen as both a driveway to the main building and walkway areas.

SUMMARY:

The restoration of this notable house and its important garden has brought back to life a wonderful parkland environment and gives the new residents the chance to enjoy the peaceful setting with new classical villas and mews houses that fit into the landscape and complement the architecture of the country house.
